Isaiah 30

King James Version (KJV)

- **30** Woe to the rebellious children, saith the LORD, that take counsel, but not of me; and that cover with a covering, but not of my spirit, that they may add sin to sin: See Ezekiel-13:20 (political correctness covers perversion and many other sins. It discourages the worship of God and teaches secularism)
- ²That walk to go down into Egypt, and have not asked at my mouth; to strengthen themselves in the strength of Pharaoh, and to trust in the shadow of Egypt! (Those who put their trust in men, instead of in God)
- ³Therefore shall the strength of Pharaoh be your shame, and the trust in the shadow of Egypt your confusion. (Egypt will not save them. Only God could have saved them, but they never asked Him)
- ⁴ For his princes were at Zoan, and his ambassadors came to Hanes. (These cities are in Egypt, south of Memphis)
- ⁵They were all ashamed of a people that could not profit them, nor be an help nor profit, but a shame, and also a reproach.
- The burden of the beasts of the south: into the land of trouble and anguish, from whence come the young and old lion, the viper and fiery flying serpent, they will carry their riches upon the shoulders of young asses, and their treasures upon the bunches of camels, to a people that shall not profit them. (Paying men with gifts and money for protection would not save them. Mercenaries have no loyalty)
- ⁷For the Egyptians shall help in vain, and to no purpose: therefore have I cried concerning this, Their strength is to sit still.
- *Now go, write it before them in a table, and note it in a book, that it may be for the time to come for ever and ever: (Write it down as an example for the latter days; written here in the Book of Isaiah)
- That this is a rebellious people, lying children, children that will not hear the law of the LORD: (the Ten Commandments; the Books of the Bible)
- ¹⁰ Which say to the seers, See not; and to the prophets, Prophesy not unto us right things, speak unto us <u>smooth things</u>, prophesy deceits:

- (smooth things = political correctness; "feel good" false doctrine. Tell us whatever makes us feel good, even if it is all lies. EXAMPLE the fly away doctrine of the rapture)
- ¹¹ Get you out of the way, turn aside out of the path, cause the Holy One of Israel to cease from before us. (Throwing God out of schools and government; that leads to false doctrine, like Islam or atheism)
- ¹² Wherefore thus saith the Holy One of Israel, Because ye despise <u>this</u> <u>word</u>, and trust in oppression and perverseness, and stay thereon: (this word= the Word of God)
- ¹³ Therefore this iniquity shall be to you as a breach ready to fall, swelling out in a high wall, whose breaking cometh suddenly at an instant. (Man's "doctrine" cannot stand, and will fall) Ezekiel-38 & 39 (God is supposed to be our wall of protection)
- ¹⁴ And he shall break it as the breaking of the potters' vessel that is broken in pieces; he shall not spare: so that there shall not be found in the bursting of it a sherd to take fire from the hearth, or to take water withal out of the pit. (Not a single piece of pottery will be left big enough to be useful for anything)
- ¹⁵ For thus saith the Lord GoD, the Holy One of Israel; In returning and rest shall ye be saved; in quietness and in confidence shall be your strength: and ye would not. (Man is too stupid to see the light; God is trying to help them but they won't even listen)
- ¹⁶ But ye said, No; for we will flee upon horses; therefore shall ye flee: and, We will ride upon the swift; therefore shall they that pursue you be swift. (Go against God, and there won't be a horse fast enough to let you escape from your enemies)
- ¹⁷ One thousand shall flee at the rebuke of one; at the rebuke of five shall ye flee: till ye be left as a beacon upon the top of a mountain, and as an ensign on an hill. (A beacon of warning to others; to show what happens to those who do not revere God)
- (Much better to be a beacon for Jesus Christ; to show the world the right way)
- ¹⁸ And therefore will the LORD wait, that he may be gracious unto you, and therefore will he be exalted, that he may have mercy upon you:

- for the LORD is a God of judgment: blessed are all they that wait for him. (God is patient and will try to save man, right up until the end)
- ¹⁹ For the people shall dwell in Zion at Jerusalem: thou shalt weep no more: he will be very gracious unto thee at the voice of thy cry; when he shall hear it, he will answer thee. (This is during the Millennium) see Jeremiah-17:7-8 (Jesus Christ is the living water)
- ²⁰ And though the Lord give you the bread of adversity, and the water of affliction, yet shall not thy teachers be removed into a corner any more, but thine eyes shall see thy teachers: (The true teachers shall not be silenced any more by the false ones. Jesus Christ taught the truth His whole life. Even while He was crucified, He taught Psalms-22)
- ²¹ And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left. Mathew-18:10 (God watches out for the ones that are faithful to Him. He leads them on the correct path)
- ²²Ye shall defile also the covering of thy graven images of silver, and the ornament of thy molten images of gold: thou shalt cast them away as a menstruous cloth; thou shalt say unto it, Get thee hence. (They will get rid of all of their idols and realize that they are trash. They will also get rid of the false teachers)
- ²³ Then shall he give the rain of thy seed, that thou shalt sow the ground withal; and bread of the increase of the earth, and it shall be fat and plenteous: in that day shall thy cattle feed in large pastures. (There will be plenty for everyone)
- ²⁴ The oxen likewise and the young asses that <u>ear the ground</u> shall eat clean provender, which hath been winnowed with the shovel and with the fan. (ear the ground= plow the ground old Anglo Saxon term) (Even your livestock have plenty to eat. There is so much that you'll need a shovel to handle it)
- ²⁵ And there shall be upon every high mountain, and upon every high hill, rivers and streams of waters in the day of the great slaughter, when the towers fall. (Towers of Babylon confusion. God will end confusion and forever when He returns. Everyone will know the truth)
- ²⁶ Moreover the light of the moon shall be as the light of the sun, and the light of the sun shall be sevenfold, as the light of seven days, in the day that the LORD bindeth up the breach of his people, and healeth

the stroke of their wound. (Light is symbolic for knowledge; darkness is symbolic for confusion)

- ²⁷ Behold, the name of the LORD cometh from far, burning with his anger, and the burden thereof is heavy: his lips are full of indignation, and his tongue as a devouring fire: (Vengence belongs to God. HIS enemies had better beware) (God's Word will devour Satan's deception and lies)
- ²⁸ And his breath, as an overflowing stream, shall reach to the midst of the neck, to sift the nations with the sieve of vanity: and there shall be a bridle in the jaws of the people, causing them to err. (God will break them up as when flour is sifted. Their own choice to follow confusion will cause them to err)
- ²⁹ Ye shall have a song, <u>as in the night when a holy solemnity is kept;</u> and gladness of heart, as when one goeth with a pipe to come into the mountain of the LORD, to the mighty One of Israel. (This is the Passover night when the death angel passed over all who had the blood of the lamb on their door) 1Corinthians-5:7-8 (Christ became our Passover for all time)
- ³⁰ And the LORD shall cause his glorious voice to be heard, and shall shew the lighting down of his arm, with the indignation of his anger, and with the flame of a devouring fire, with scattering, and tempest, and hailstones. (People will witness the true power of God)
- ³¹ For through the voice of the LORD shall the Assyrian be beaten down, which smote with a rod. (The Assyrian is a type for antichrist. God's truth destroys Satan's lies)
- ³² And in every place where the grounded staff shall pass, which the LORD shall lay upon him, it shall be with tabrets and harps: and in battles of shaking will he fight with it. (God, Himself, fights the final battles of Armageddon and Hamon-gog)
- ³³ For Tophet is ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made it deep and large: the pile thereof is fire and much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, doth kindle it. (Tophet- the place of cremation; It is in the valley of Hinnon Gehenna) (The king here is Moloch; to whom the heathen sacrificed their own children through the fire)
