## Jeremiah 13

King James Version (KJV)

- **13** Thus saith the LORD unto me, Go and get thee a linen girdle, and put it upon thy loins, and put it not in water. (Wear it until it is rank) (Also in Ephesians-6, the girt is the Word of God; this parables shows what man can do to the Word of God)
- <sup>2</sup>So I got a girdle according to the word of the LORD, and put it on my loins. (God uses symbolism to teach what the world will do to everything)
- <sup>3</sup> And the word of the LORD came unto me the second time, saying,
- <sup>4</sup>Take the girdle that thou hast got, which is upon thy loins, and arise, go to Euphrates, and hide it there in a hole of the rock. (It was worn, but not cleaned)
- <sup>5</sup>So I went, and hid it by Euphrates, as the LORD commanded me. (River Euphrates is on the border between Israel and Babylon, which means confusion or babble)
- <sup>6</sup> And it came to pass after many days, that the LORD said unto me, Arise, go to Euphrates, and take the girdle from thence, which I commanded thee to hide there.
- <sup>7</sup>Then I went to Euphrates, and digged, and took the girdle from the place where I had hid it: and, behold, the girdle was marred, it was profitable for nothing. (It was completely spoiled)
- \*Then the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- <sup>9</sup>Thus saith the LORD, After this manner will I mar the pride of Judah, and the great pride of Jerusalem. (They will be abased due to their rebelling against God's Word) (God says this is how my children feel around me like a marred girdle)

(This is also the value of God's word, after people change it to suit the traditions of men; example - the NIV Bible changed many important passages and verses, to the point that they voided the meaning of those verses)

<sup>10</sup> This evil people, which refuse to hear my words, which walk in the imagination of their heart, and walk after other gods, to serve them,

and to worship them, shall even be as this girdle, which is good for nothing. (Purported Christians who teach rapture, Easter, and all the other traditions of men, instead of the true Word of God)

- <sup>11</sup> For as the girdle cleaveth to the loins of a man, so have I caused to cleave unto me the whole house of Israel and the whole house of Judah, saith the LORD; that they might be unto me for a people, and for a name, and for a praise, and for a glory: but they would not hear. (They are too stupid to know what is good for them. They refuse to learn God's Word. Today, most Caucasians think that they are gentiles, instead of descendants of the migrated 10 tribes of Israel, who settled Europe and North America)
- <sup>12</sup> Therefore thou shalt speak unto them this word; Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Every bottle shall be filled with wine: and they shall say unto thee, Do we not certainly know that every bottle shall be filled with wine?
- <sup>13</sup> Then shalt thou say unto them, Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will fill all the inhabitants of this land, even the kings that sit upon David's throne, and the priests, and the prophets, and all the inhabitants of Jerusalem, with drunkenness. (The deceived will be as in a drunken stupor)
- <sup>14</sup> And I will dash them one against another, even the fathers and the sons together, saith the LORD: I will not pity, nor spare, nor have mercy, but destroy them. (Like earthen wine bottles, dashing them one against another will break the whole bunch. They will turn against each other and then they will be judged and punished for their idolatry)
- <sup>15</sup> Hear ye, and give ear; be not proud: for the LORD hath spoken.
- <sup>16</sup> Give glory to the LORD your God, before he cause darkness, and before your feet stumble upon the dark mountains, and, while ye look for light, he turn it into the shadow of death, and make it gross darkness. (They had better return to God and be blessed or they will stumble around as people in the darkness and confusion of antichrist)
- <sup>17</sup>But if ye will not hear it, my soul shall weep in secret places for your pride; and mine eye shall weep sore, and run down with tears, because the LORD's flock is carried away captive.

- <sup>18</sup> Say unto the king and to the queen, Humble yourselves, sit down: for your principalities shall come down, even the crown of your glory. (God is appealing to the leaders of the world to humble themselves and get off of their ego trips)
- <sup>19</sup> The <u>cities</u> of the south shall be shut up, and none shall open them: Judah shall be carried away captive all of it, it shall be wholly carried away captive. (cities = eyes - translation error from the manuscripts it was pointed out in the Masorah)

(The eyes of the south are looking south. The enemy comes in from the north. No one is prepared. In the future, antichrist will come in and catch everyone off guard. No one will be prepared for his level of deceit)

- <sup>20</sup> Lift up your eyes, and behold them that come from the north: where is the flock that was given thee, thy beautiful flock? (The enemy will come from the north; then, it was Babylon; future- Antichrist with the Kenites and the muslims the locust army of Revelation)
- <sup>21</sup> What wilt thou say when he shall punish thee? for thou hast taught them to be captains, and as chief over thee: shall not sorrows take thee, as a woman in travail? (them the gentiles; you put them over yourselves and trained them to be your rulers)

(We train them to do our fighting in other nations, and then we wonder why they are so skilled, when they come back to attack us. Even worse, we welcome them into our countries and raise them up to be our leaders – all for political correctness)

- <sup>22</sup> And if thou say in thine heart, Wherefore come these things upon me? For the greatness of thine iniquity are thy skirts discovered, and thy heels made bare. (You brought it upon yourselves; you were caught right in the act of idolatry and idiocy)
- <sup>23</sup> Can the Ethiopian change his skin, or the leopard his spots? then may ye also do good, that are accustomed to do evil. (Just as they can't change the way they look, neither can you doers of evil change to do good)
- <sup>24</sup>Therefore will I scatter them as the stubble that passeth away by the wind of the wilderness. (The Assyrians took Israel, the Babylonians took Judah All were later scattered, and they migrated over the Caucasus Mountains and settled Europe and later America as

Caucasians. Now we bring in the same people <muslims> into our countries. They have no intension of joining us. They are here to take over. They hate Christians and Jews – always have and always will)

- <sup>25</sup> This is thy lot, the portion of thy measures from me, saith the LORD; because thou hast forgotten me, and trusted in falsehood. (They listened to fake preachers that taught traditions of men, and couldn't care less. They listened to political and religious rivals and blindly trusted them as friends)
- <sup>26</sup> Therefore will I discover thy skirts upon thy face, that thy shame may appear. (God will expose what you did) Revelation-9 (The deceived people are ashamed of what they did, when Jesus returns. They pray for mountains to fall on them)
- <sup>27</sup>I have seen thine adulteries, and thy neighings, the lewdness of thy whoredom, and thine abominations on the hills in the fields. Woe unto thee, O Jerusalem! wilt thou not be made clean? when shall it once be? (God sees idolatry as adultery and whoredom. He will clean Jerusalem upon His return. That will begin the Millennium period)
