

1 John 2

King James Version (KJV)

2 My little children, these things write I unto you, that ye sin not. And if any man sin, we have an advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous: (This is a habitual sinner – in the Greek; not like a normal sin that we all can make. A habitual sinner doesn't care to stop the sin. They repeat it thinking that it's OK because they can repent as often as they like. They are taking God for a fool)

²And he is the propitiation for our sins: and not for ours only, but also for the sins of the whole world. (propitiation= the atonement) (To whosoever will believe on Him)

³And hereby we do know that we know him, if we keep his commandments. (Do your best to obey the Ten Commandments and live a good honest life. If you fail, repent, and get right with God)

⁴He that saith, I know him, and keepeth not his commandments, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. (We all sin, occasionally, but with repentance, we're back in God's grace)

⁵But whoso keepeth his word, in him verily is the love of God perfected: hereby know we that we are in him. (perfected= matured, fully grown – better translation)

⁶He that saith he abideth in him ought himself also so to walk, even as he walked. (Stay in the light; stay in the Word; do what is right; we all have a conscience to know right from wrong)

⁷Brethren, I write no new commandment unto you, but an old commandment which ye had from the beginning. The old commandment is the word which ye have heard from the beginning. (God gave Moses the Ten Commandments. Those are God's laws. They never change) Ecclesiastes (There's nothing new under the sun)

⁸Again, a new commandment I write unto you, which thing is true in him and in you: because the darkness is past, and the true light now shineth. (Jesus' sacrifice of crucifixion for us opened salvation to the world. HE defeated death, which is one of Satan's names. This is the New Testament)

⁹ He that saith he is in the light, and hateth his brother, is in darkness even until now. (his brother- this is a true brother, of the same womb; not a figurative "brother")

2Tessalonians-3:6 (tells us how to handle a difficult brother. Don't hate him as Cain hated Abel. If he is impossible to get along with, set him aside and pray for him – tough love. Don't be an enabler for someone who does evil)

¹⁰ He that loveth his brother abideth in the light, and there is none occasion of stumbling in him. (Hate can cause us to fail) (The light is Jesus Christ – obeying His teachings is to be in the light)

¹¹ But he that hateth his brother is in darkness, and walketh in darkness, and knoweth not whither he goeth, because that darkness hath blinded his eyes. (Cain hated Able) (Hate, like anger, is a form of insanity)

¹² I write unto you, little children, because your sins are forgiven you for his name's sake. (Jesus is the Savior of the world. When we repent, we are forgiven in the name of Jesus)

¹³ I write unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I write unto you, young men, because ye have overcome the wicked one. I write unto you, little children, because ye have known the Father. (In these epistles)

¹⁴ I have written unto you, fathers, because ye have known him that is from the beginning. I have written unto you, young men, because ye are strong, and the word of God abideth in you, and ye have overcome the wicked one. (In the Gospel of John)

(Later, John also penned the Book of Revelation)

¹⁵ Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him. (A person can only have one following. The ways of the world are opposite the ways of God)

¹⁶ For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world. (Lust, envy, greed, pride – these are the ways of the world)

¹⁷ And the world passeth away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abideth for ever. (We will live with God in the eternity, if we choose God over the world)

¹⁸ Little children, it is the last time: and as ye have heard that antichrist shall come, even now are there many antichrists; whereby we know that it is the last time. Matthew-24:24 (In the Greek, anti means instead of; Satan will come first at the 6th Trump, instead of Christ. He will deceive the whole world into worshipping him. Christ will come afterwards, at the 7th Trump)

(This verse should be enough to convince people that the rapture is false doctrine. The antichrist will come and we will be here to witness for God before the whole world) Mark-13, Matthew-24, Luke-21

¹⁹ They went out from us, but they were not of us; for if they had been of us, they would no doubt have continued with us: but they went out, that they might be made manifest that they were not all of us. John-8:44-47 (These are the Kenites)

²⁰ But ye have an unction from the Holy One, and ye know all things. (an unction= charisma, a gift from God) (ye know all things – you have a conscience to intuitively discern good from evil)

²¹ I have not written unto you because ye know not the truth, but because ye know it, and that no lie is of the truth. John-8:44

²² Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son. (To stand against the truth is to be a liar)

²³ Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also. (The Father and the Son are one God, in two different forms. You can't have one without the other. There is one God; He has many offices. Jesus said – If you've seen me, you've seen the Father)

²⁴ Let that therefore abide in you, which ye have heard from the beginning. If that which ye have heard from the beginning shall remain in you, ye also shall continue in the Son, and in the Father. (Spiritually - From the beginning; not a verse here and there, out of context; physically – We have existed in the first, the second, and will continue in the third Age)

²⁵ And this is the promise that he hath promised us, even eternal life.
(If we choose to follow God, instead of the world)

²⁶ These things have I written unto you concerning them that seduce you. (false teachers, the fallen angels, antichrist)

²⁷ But the anointing which ye have received of him abideth in you, and ye need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teacheth you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it hath taught you, ye shall abide in him. (When we will be delivered before antichrist, God will teach us in that moment, what we will say)
Mark-13:9-11

²⁸ And now, little children, abide in him; that, when he shall appear, we may have confidence, and not be ashamed before him at his coming.
(Prepare now, in order to be ready and well taught when He returns)

²⁹ If ye know that he is righteous, ye know that every one that doeth righteousness is born of him. (To be a Christian is to try to live righteously, as Jesus did)
