

## Isaiah 65

King James Version (KJV)

(answer to prayer of chapter 64)

**65** I am sought of them that asked not for me; I am found of them that sought me not: I said, Behold me, behold me, unto a nation that was not called by my name. (I am-> the Lord's name – Yah) (They preach "God", but HE never sent them. They don't teach His Word. They preach their own sermons instead)

<sup>2</sup>I have spread out my hands all the day unto a rebellious people, which walketh in a way that was not good, after their own thoughts; (God spreads out His hands to give us salvation. Instead, preachers teach traditions of men, and false teachings)

<sup>3</sup>A people that provoketh me to anger continually to my face; that sacrificeth in gardens, and burneth incense upon altars of brick; (They insult God; practice idolatry, all against God's instructions) (A brick altar was against God's commands. HE told them to build an altar of natural stones) (Today, anything that people put first before God is also an idol)

<sup>4</sup>Which remain among the graves, and lodge in the monuments, which eat swine's flesh, and broth of abominable things is in their vessels; Leviticus-11(God told people not to eat swine)

<sup>5</sup>Which say, Stand by thyself, come not near to me; for I am holier than thou. These are a smoke in my nose, a fire that burneth all the day. (Fake Christians who never study God's true Word. God expects us to help each other, if we can. Holier than thou people are offensive to God)

<sup>6</sup>Behold, it is written before me: I will not keep silence, but will recompense, even recompense into their bosom, Deuteronomy-32:32-36

<sup>7</sup>Your iniquities, and the iniquities of your fathers together, saith the LORD, which have burned incense upon the mountains, and blasphemed me upon the hills: therefore will I measure their former work into their bosom. (God will not be mocked)

<sup>8</sup>Thus saith the LORD, As the new wine is found in the cluster, and one saith, Destroy it not; for a blessing is in it: so will I do for my servants' sakes, that I may not destroy them all. (HE won't destroy evil nations,

because there are some good people in every nation. HE spares the nation for their sake)

<sup>9</sup> And I will bring forth a seed out of Jacob, and out of Judah an inheritor of my mountains: and mine elect shall inherit it, and my servants shall dwell there. (Mountains are nations; the seed are the Elect, who will testify against antichrist to wake people up to the deception in the end times) See Ezekiel-44

<sup>10</sup> And Sharon shall be a fold of flocks, and the valley of Achor a place for the herds to lie down in, for my people that have sought me. (Sharon – a fertile plain between Jerusalem and the Med Sea) (Achor= trouble; it will become a peaceful place to rest)

<sup>11</sup> But ye are they that forsake the LORD, that forget my holy mountain, that prepare a table for that troop, and that furnish the drink offering unto that number. (troop = gad<Hebrew> - the god of fate & luck; number = mini<Hebrew> - false god of destiny; both are heathen idols)

(NOTE: Mini was also one of the words that Nebuchadnezzar's grandson saw written on the wall by an unattached hand, in the Book of Daniel)

(People listen to fake teachers and then they will blame them for their not making it before God. God sent the letter to everyone. Blame yourself for listening to fake preachers instead of learning the Bible)

<sup>12</sup> Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose that wherein I delighted not. (Look at Easter; God finds it an abomination; people know it, yet they still celebrate Easter out of "tradition" – traditions of men, who make void the Word of God)

<sup>13</sup> Therefore thus saith the Lord God, Behold, my servants shall eat, but ye shall be hungry: behold, my servants shall drink, but ye shall be thirsty: behold, my servants shall rejoice, but ye shall be ashamed: (Spiritual food – God's Word)

<sup>14</sup> Behold, my servants shall sing for joy of heart, but ye shall cry for sorrow of heart, and shall howl for vexation of spirit. **Isaiah-43:26**

<sup>15</sup> And ye shall leave your name for a curse unto my chosen: for the Lord GOD shall slay thee, and call his servants by another name: (Beulah – married <to God>)

<sup>16</sup> That he who blesseth himself in the earth shall bless himself in the God of truth; and he that sweareth in the earth shall swear by the God of truth; because the former troubles are forgotten, and because they are hid from mine eyes. (Upon repentance, God forgives)

<sup>17</sup> For, behold, I create new heavens and a new earth: and the former shall not be remembered, nor come into mind. (A new heaven and earth AGE – called the eternity) (This age will not be remembered, so there will be no sorrow in the next age)

<sup>18</sup> But be ye glad and rejoice for ever in that which I create: for, behold, I create Jerusalem a rejoicing, and her people a joy. (This will happen when God rejuvenates the world, after the Lord's Day)

<sup>19</sup> And I will rejoice in Jerusalem, and joy in my people: and the voice of weeping shall be no more heard in her, nor the voice of crying. (All evil will be gone)

<sup>20</sup> There shall be no more thence an infant of days, nor an old man that hath not filled his days: for the child shall die an hundred years old; but the sinner being an hundred years old shall be accursed. (accursed= cut off) (All who live will be in spiritual bodies, and ageless; no babies, no old people)

<sup>21</sup> And they shall build houses, and inhabit them; and they shall plant vineyards, and eat the fruit of them. (No taxation or usury; you keep what you produce)

<sup>22</sup> They shall not build, and another inhabit; they shall not plant, and another eat: for as the days of a tree are the days of my people, and mine elect shall long enjoy the work of their hands. (What you make will be all yours. No more usury; no more men rulers over you)

<sup>23</sup> They shall not labour in vain, nor bring forth for trouble; for they are the seed of the blessed of the LORD, and their offspring with them. (All are God's children; no more generations to be born)

<sup>24</sup> And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear. (God will be over all people, as it should be)

<sup>25</sup>The wolf and the lamb shall feed together, and the lion shall eat straw like the bullock: and dust shall be the serpent's meat. They shall not hurt nor destroy in all my holy mountain, saith the LORD. (No more flesh, no more carnivores, no more prey)
