

## Psalm 20

## A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

**20** The LORD hear thee in the day of trouble; the name of the God of Jacob defend thee; (Jacob refers to all 12 tribes of Israel) (defend -> set thee on a high place)

<sup>2</sup>Send thee help from the sanctuary, and strengthen thee out of Zion;

<sup>3</sup>Remember all thy offerings, and accept thy burnt sacrifice; Selah. (accept- turn to ashes)

<sup>4</sup>Grant thee according to thine own heart, and fulfill all thy counsel.

<sup>5</sup>We will rejoice in thy salvation, and in the name of our God we will set up our banners: the LORD fulfill all thy petitions. Our banner-> see Isaiah-9:22

<sup>6</sup>Now know I that the LORD saveth his anointed; he will hear him from his holy heaven with the saving strength of his right hand.

<sup>7</sup>Some trust in chariots, and some in horses: but we will remember the name of the LORD our God. (David faced Goliath, and won with God's help)

<sup>8</sup>They are brought down and fallen: but we are risen, and stand upright.

<sup>9</sup>Save, LORD: let the king hear us when we call. (aka- God save the king)
