**2** Why do the heathen rage, and the people imagine a vain thing?  
(heathen= nations)(rage- in their assemblies)(Imagine= meditate)

<sup>2</sup>The kings of the earth set themselves, and the rulers take counsel together, against the LORD, and against his anointed, saying, (They seek council from each other, not from God)

<sup>3</sup>Let us break their bands asunder, and cast away their cords from us.  
(Working to destroy Christianity) (Christians need to stay clear of their drama and their chains)

<sup>4</sup>He that sitteth in the heavens shall laugh: the LORD shall have them in derision.

<sup>5</sup>Then shall he speak unto them in his wrath, and vex them in his sore displeasure. (vex- trouble) (When Jesus returns)

<sup>6</sup>Yet have I set my king upon my holy hill of Zion. (When Jesus returns)

<sup>7</sup>I will declare the decree: the LORD hath said unto me, Thou art my Son; this day have I begotten thee. [Matthew-3:17](#), [Acts-13:33](#)

<sup>8</sup>Ask of me, and I shall give thee the heathen for thine inheritance, and the uttermost parts of the earth for thy possession.

<sup>9</sup>Thou shalt break them with a rod of iron; thou shalt dash them in pieces like a potter's vessel. [Revelation-2:27](#)

<sup>10</sup>Be wise now therefore, O ye kings: be instructed, ye judges of the earth. (Learn the word of God, before it is too late) (Judge morally, not by precedent)

<sup>11</sup>Serve the LORD with fear, and rejoice with trembling. (fear-reverence) (Trembling – meekly)

<sup>12</sup>Kiss the Son, lest he be angry, and ye perish from the way, when his wrath is kindled but a little. Blessed are all they that put their trust in him. (Show your love for Jesus)
