

Psalm 149

King James Version (KJV)

149 Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, and his praise in the congregation of saints. (saints= the elect)

²Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King.

³Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp.

⁴For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. **Revelation-4:11**

⁵Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds.

⁶Let the high praises of God be in their mouth, and a two-edged sword in their hand; **Hebrews-4:12, Revelation-1:16, (This is the Word of God)**

⁷To execute vengeance upon the heathen, and punishments upon the people; **Deuteronomy-32:35**

⁸To bind their kings with chains, and their nobles with fetters of iron; **Numbers-24:24**

⁹To execute upon them the judgment written: this honour have all his saints. Praise ye the LORD.

Some believe that these last 5 Psalms form a group – each psalm is equivalent to one of the 5 Books of Moses – from-Genesis to Deuteronomy. Also they all begin and end with Hallelujah.
