

Amos 4

King James Version (KJV)

4 Hear this word, ye kine of Bashan, that are in the mountain of Samaria, which oppress the poor, which crush the needy, which say to their masters, Bring, and let us drink. (Fat cows – fake preachers fleecing the flock for all that they have by asking for “tithes” and “donations”. They are selling tickets to heaven, as if God needs our money)

²The Lord GOD hath sworn by his holiness, that, lo, the days shall come upon you, that he will take you away with hooks, and your posterity with fishhooks. **Jeremiah-16:16**

³And ye shall go out at the breaches, every cow at that which is before her; and ye shall cast them into the palace, saith the LORD. (Palace = citadel or church) (They are like frightened cattle that are stampeding. The fake preachers will throw them right back into their churches with threats of fire, brimstone and hell)

⁴Come to Bethel, and transgress; at Gilgal multiply transgression; and bring your sacrifices every morning, and your tithes after three years: (Bethel- House of God; Gilgal- rolling wheel) (three years = three days – in the manuscripts – bad translation) (Giving tithes to fake preachers does not please God. You are giving to the wrong people. It helps no one but the fake preachers)

⁵And offer a sacrifice of thanksgiving with leaven, and proclaim and publish the free offerings: for this liketh you, O ye children of Israel, saith the Lord GOD. (Keep sacrificing to idols, for all the good it will do you. You're not doing god's work. Your fake preachers don't teach God's Word. They teach traditions of men and false doctrine)

⁶And I also have given you cleanness of teeth in all your cities, and want of bread in all your places: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. (cleanness of teeth – nothing to eat – you're starving <for knowledge of God's Word>)

Amos-8:11 (The famine of the end times is not for bread; it is for hearing the true Word of God)

⁷And also I have withholden the rain from you, when there were yet three months to the harvest: and I caused it to rain upon one city, and caused it not to rain upon another city: one piece was rained upon,

and the piece whereupon it rained not withered. (Withholding 3 months of rain will destroy the crops. Famine for the unjust, food for the just) (God hopes the unjust will see God's blessings on the just, and they will wake up and return to God)

⁸So two or three cities wandered unto one city, to drink water; but they were not satisfied: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. (There wasn't enough for all because of the overcrowding, and still they didn't repent)

⁹I have smitten you with blasting and mildew: when your gardens and your vineyards and your fig trees and your olive trees increased, the palmerworm devoured them: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. See Joel (The palmerworm is part of the locust army < the Kenites>. The locust has devoured their harvest, and they didn't turn back to God)

¹⁰I have sent among you the pestilence after the manner of Egypt: your young men have I slain with the sword, and have taken away your horses; and I have made the stink of your camps to come up unto your nostrils: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. (The plagues of Egypt will be repeated in the 7 vials of the end times) (After WW2, the US and Europe descended into political correctness, perversion, atheism, islam. They traded in their Christian values for the ways of the world – greed, corruption, power, etc)

¹¹I have overthrown some of you, as God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah, and ye were as a firebrand plucked out of the burning: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD. (Gay marriage, gay army, transgender, child trafficking, perverts, atheists, agnostics, muslim converts building mosques in the west)

¹²Therefore thus will I do unto thee, O Israel: and because I will do this unto thee, prepare to meet thy God, O Israel. (You should always try to be prepared to meet God. If you're not ready, then you are living the wrong way)

¹³For, lo, he that formeth the mountains, and createth the wind, and declareth unto man what is his thought, that maketh the morning darkness, and treadeth upon the high places of the earth, The LORD, The God of hosts, is his name. (That's that = Amen)
