

## Luke 21

King James Version (KJV)

**21** And he looked up, and saw the rich men casting their gifts into the treasury.

<sup>2</sup>And he saw also a certain poor widow casting in thither two mites. (a mite is 3/8 of a farthing, or 3/16 of a cent)

<sup>3</sup>And he said, Of a truth I say unto you, that this poor widow hath cast in more than they all: (She gave all she had, they gave a tithe)

<sup>4</sup>For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had. (penury= poverty)

<sup>5</sup>And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said,

<sup>6</sup>As for these things which ye behold, the days will come, in the which there shall not be left one stone upon another, that shall not be thrown down. (After antichrist pollutes it, God will cleanse it, upon his return) See Mathew-24, Mark-13 for additional info

<sup>7</sup>And they asked him, saying, Master, but when shall these things be? and what sign will there be when these things shall come to pass? Mathew-24:3

<sup>8</sup>And he said, Take heed that ye be not deceived: for many shall come in my name, saying, I am Christ; and the time draweth near: go ye not therefore after them. (Fake preachers looking to deceive people; also, Satan will come disguised as Jesus)

<sup>9</sup>But when ye shall hear of wars and commotions, be not terrified: for these things must first come to pass; but the end is not by and by. (not by and by = not right away) (The end will come when you hear "peace, peace"; not wars and rumors of war)

<sup>10</sup>Then said he unto them, Nation shall rise against nation, and kingdom against kingdom: (Countries will turn against each other)

<sup>11</sup>And great earthquakes shall be in divers places, and famines, and pestilences; and fearful sights and great signs shall there be from heaven. Amos-8:11 (The famine for hearing the Word of God, not a

famine of bread) (Signs from heaven - Satan will be cast out with his angels) Revelation-9

<sup>12</sup> But before all these, they shall lay their hands on you, and persecute you, delivering you up to the synagogues, and into prisons, being brought before kings and rulers for my name's sake. (Christians will be ridiculed and preyed upon by atheists, muslims and SJW's and the politically correct. Later, the Elect will be delivered up before Satan)

<sup>13</sup> And it shall turn to you for a testimony. Mark-13:10-12

<sup>14</sup> Settle it therefore in your hearts, not to meditate before what ye shall answer:

<sup>15</sup> For I will give you a mouth and wisdom, which all your adversaries shall not be able to gainsay nor resist. (The Holy Spirit will speak through them, in all languages at once, to the whole world -> Joel-2)

<sup>16</sup> And ye shall be betrayed both by parents, and brethren, and kinsfolks, and friends; and some of you shall they cause to be put to death. (They will think they are delivering them to Jesus, but it will be the antichrist, pretending to be Jesus. Satan's name is death. See Hebrews-2:14)

<sup>17</sup> And ye shall be hated of all men for my name's sake. (Political correctness and islam are attacking Christianity on a daily basis)

<sup>18</sup> But there shall not an hair of your head perish. Revelation-9:4

<sup>19</sup> In your patience possess ye your souls. (Wait through the tribulation of Satan, and you will see the true Christ return afterwards)

<sup>20</sup> And when ye shall see Jerusalem compassed with armies, then know that the desolation thereof is nigh. (Satan is about to arrive as antichrist) (desolation / desolator – same word in Hebrew) ( This is the 6<sup>th</sup> trump in Revelation)

<sup>21</sup> Then let them which are in Judaea flee to the mountains; and let them which are in the midst of it depart out; and let not them that are in the countries enter thereinto. (That's where antichrist will set up his church)

<sup>22</sup> For these be the days of vengeance, that all things which are written may be fulfilled. (Luke-4:18-19 -> this is the other half of the verse in Isaiah, that Jesus didn't read. See Isaiah-61:1-2)

<sup>23</sup> But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people. (These are people who were seduced by Satan, the antichrist, and do the work of his "church") (Those with child and giving suck – an analogy for the deceived at the 6<sup>th</sup> trump, who are nursing along Satan's church – This is also known as the Mark of the Beast. The great wedding doesn't happen until the 7<sup>th</sup> trump, when the true Jesus returns as the bridegroom, looking for His spiritual virgin bride)

<sup>24</sup> And they shall fall by the edge of the sword, and shall be led away captive into all nations: and Jerusalem shall be trodden down of the Gentiles, until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. (Gentiles= ethnos, nations) (The dome of the rock is still there, today. The Gentiles are still occupying Moriah)

<sup>25</sup> And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;

<sup>26</sup> Men's hearts failing them for fear, and for looking after those things which are coming on the earth: for the powers of heaven shall be shaken. (Satan and his angels battle with Michael and his angels) Daniel-9:27 (Michael prevails and boots Satan out of Heaven, onto the Earth)

<sup>27</sup> And then shall they see the Son of man coming in a cloud with power and great glory. (The true Christ returns after the deception of Satan is complete)

<sup>28</sup> And when these things begin to come to pass, then look up, and lift up your heads; for your redemption draweth nigh. (Satan's rule only lasts 5 months. Then Jesus returns)

<sup>29</sup> And he spake to them a parable; Behold the fig tree, and all the trees; (This parable started in the Garden of Eden, in Genesis, and it will end at the deception of the world by Satan and the Kenites) Also see Jeremiah-24

<sup>30</sup> When they now shoot forth, ye see and know of your own selves that summer is now nigh at hand. (When Israel is re-formed as a nation, the good and bad figs will return – May 15, 1948) (The figs are the Israelites and the Kenites, who pretend to be Jews)

<sup>31</sup> So likewise ye, when ye see these things come to pass, know ye that the kingdom of God is nigh at hand.

<sup>32</sup> Verily I say unto you, This generation shall not pass away, till all be fulfilled.

<sup>33</sup> Heaven and earth shall pass away: but my words shall not pass away. (This age will pass away, but God's word will happen as foretold) 2Peter-3

<sup>34</sup> And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and so that day come upon you unawares. (surfeiting= a hangover, from overdrinking)

<sup>35</sup> For as a snare shall it come on all them that dwell on the face of the whole earth. (It will come suddenly and unexpectedly; most people will think Jesus is already here, but they will have been worshipping antichrist for the last 5 months)

<sup>36</sup> Watch ye therefore, and pray always, that ye may be accounted worthy to escape all these things that shall come to pass, and to stand before the Son of man. (We escape Satan's "hour of temptation" by knowing the truth that he is antichrist, and not Jesus, returned)

<sup>37</sup> And in the day time he was teaching in the temple; and at night he went out, and abode in the mount that is called the mount of Olives.

<sup>38</sup> And all the people came early in the morning to him in the temple, for to hear him. (Jesus continued to teach, right up to the time that the Kenites murdered Him on the cross)
