

Jeremiah 50

King James Version (KJV)

50 The word that the LORD spake against Babylon and against the land of the Chaldeans by Jeremiah the prophet. (The fall of confusion; Babel means confusion) (This is the 50th prophecy of God through Jeremiah) (Today this is Iraq; Saddam rebuilt the ruins of Babylon) (Spiritually - confusion is spread throughout the world – political correctness, homosexuality, atheism, abortion, etc...)

² Declare ye among the nations, and publish, and set up a standard; publish, and conceal not: say, Babylon is taken, Bel is confounded, Merodach is broken in pieces; her idols are confounded, her images are broken in pieces. (Bel was a god in Babylon) (Merodach = death; death is one of Satan's names. The countries will wake up in the end and march against antichrist's one world system – possibly Russia coming from the north?)

³ For out of the north there cometh up a nation against her, which shall make her land desolate, and none shall dwell therein: they shall remove, they shall depart, both man and beast. (In the past, this was Nebuchadnezzar; future antichrist will take everything)

⁴ In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the children of Israel shall come, they and the children of Judah together, going and weeping: they shall go, and seek the LORD their God. (Finally, they turn back to God as one house)

⁵ They shall ask the way to Zion with their faces thitherward, saying, Come, and let us join ourselves to the LORD in a perpetual covenant that shall not be forgotten. (When Jesus returns)

⁶ My people hath been lost sheep: their shepherds have caused them to go astray, they have turned them away on the mountains: they have gone from mountain to hill, they have forgotten their resting place. (Our resting place = our Sabbath; Jesus became our Sabbath, our rest; Christian preachers today don't even teach the true Word of God. They teach rapture and other traditions of men. They celebrate Easter – a heathen ritual celebration to Ishtar, the pagan goddess of heaven)

⁷ All that found them have devoured them: and their adversaries said, We offend not, because they have sinned against the LORD, the habitation of justice, even the LORD, the hope of their fathers. (All

others took advantage of them. They have forgotten God and now are everyone else's suckers)

(Look at the Christian countries of Europe and North America today. Most don't even know that they are descendents of the scattered 10 tribes of Israel. They call themselves gentiles. They have become the invaded; conquered by muslims and other heathen peoples without even a battle; they are all losing their own countries to these invaders because of political correctness and fear of being called racist)

⁸ Remove out of the midst of Babylon, and go forth out of the land of the Chaldeans, and be as the he goats before the flocks. (They pranced and they led the flock; in this case, lead them out of confusion<Babel>)

⁹ For, lo, I will raise and cause to come up against Babylon an assembly of great nations from the north country: and they shall set themselves in array against her; from thence she shall be taken: their arrows shall be as of a mighty expert man; none shall return in vain. Isaiah-13:3-5 (Past- Medial Persia; Future- God's army confronting antichrist in Jerusalem?) Also see Ezekiel-38 & 39

¹⁰ And Chaldea shall be a spoil: all that spoil her shall be satisfied, saith the LORD. (The great harlot, Babylon – land of the confused, who will believe that antichrist, is Jesus, returned) (Babel = confusion)

¹¹ Because ye were glad, because ye rejoiced, O ye destroyers of mine heritage, because ye are grown fat as the heifer at grass, and bellow as bulls; (They were delighted to rule corruptly over God's people)

¹² Your mother shall be sore confounded; she that bare you shall be ashamed: behold, the hindermost of the nations shall be a wilderness, a dry land, and a desert.

¹³ Because of the wrath of the LORD it shall not be inhabited, but it shall be wholly desolate: every one that goeth by Babylon shall be astonished, and hiss at all her plagues. Revelation-18 (Give her <Babylon> a double portion of God's wrath)

(In the end times, Babylon is not a place. It's a condition. It is all those that were deceived by and serve antichrist when Jesus returns)

¹⁴ Put yourselves in array against Babylon round about: all ye that bend the bow, shoot at her, spare no arrows: for she hath sinned

against the LORD. (By deceiving the people through antichrist's confusion and lies) (The arrows are symbolic for of when the Elect testify the truth from the Holy Spirit in front of antichrist. The whole world will hear their testimony and many will wake up to the truth)

¹⁵ Shout against her round about: she hath given her hand: her foundations are fallen, her walls are thrown down: for it is the vengeance of the LORD: take vengeance upon her; as she hath done, do unto her. (God's truth will destroy the lies of antichrist)

¹⁶ Cut off the sower from Babylon, and him that handleth the sickle in the time of harvest: for fear of the oppressing sword they shall turn every one to his people, and they shall flee every one to his own land. (They will stop the false planting and harvest of antichrist. The crop here is souls)

¹⁷ Israel is a scattered sheep; the lions have driven him away: first the king of Assyria hath devoured him; and last this Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath broken his bones. (600 BC, the Assyrians took the 10 northern tribes and scattered them over the Caucasus Mountains. 200 years later, Babylon <Nebuchadnezzar> took Judah and Benjamin captive)

¹⁸ Therefore thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Behold, I will punish the king of Babylon and his land, as I have punished the king of Assyria. (Both very strong types for antichrist – both were destroyed for having persecuted Israel and Judah)

¹⁹ And I will bring Israel again to his habitation, and he shall feed on Carmel and Bashan, and his soul shall be satisfied upon mount Ephraim and Gilead. (Carmel = a pleasant fruitful place; Bashan = a fertile place) (Ephraim = the forgetful one)

²⁰ In those days, and in that time, saith the LORD, the iniquity of Israel shall be sought for, and there shall be none; and the sins of Judah, and they shall not be found: for I will pardon them whom I reserve. (On the Lord's Day) (reserve = save better translation; God will forgive and save those who repent and seek Him and love Him)

²¹ Go up against the land of Merathaim, even against it, and against the inhabitants of Pekod: waste and utterly destroy after them, saith the LORD, and do according to all that I have commanded thee. (Merathaim= double rebellion; Pekod= visitation or judgment)

²² A sound of battle is in the land, and of great destruction.

²³ How is the hammer of the whole earth cut asunder and broken! how is Babylon become a desolation among the nations! (Babylon – confusion; when Jesus returns all people wake up and confusion is ended; the hammer here stands prophetically for antichrist in the end times)

²⁴ I have laid a snare for thee, and thou art also taken, O Babylon, and thou wast not aware: thou art found, and also caught, because thou hast striven against the LORD. (God gave Satan plenty of rope, and he hung himself with it. All his misdeeds will catch up with him in the end times)

²⁵ The LORD hath opened his armoury, and hath brought forth the weapons of his indignation: for this is the work of the Lord GOD of hosts in the land of the Chaldeans. (Spiritually - God opens the armory, but we have to take up the weapons <the truth> and fight against antichrist's deception)

²⁶ Come against her from the utmost border, open her storehouses: cast her up as heaps, and destroy her utterly: let nothing of her be left. (Her - Babylon = confusion and false doctrine)

²⁷ Slay all her bullocks; let them go down to the slaughter: woe unto them! for their day is come, the time of their visitation. (Destroy her wealth; the judgment of Babylon – on the Lord's Day)

²⁸ The voice of them that flee and escape out of the land of Babylon, to declare in Zion the vengeance of the LORD our God, the vengeance of his temple. (The Lord's temple in the end times is the many membered body of Christianity)

²⁹ Call together the archers against Babylon: all ye that bend the bow, camp against it round about; let none thereof escape: recompense her according to her work; according to all that she hath done, do unto her: for she hath been proud against the LORD, against the Holy One of Israel. Revelation- 18:6

³⁰ Therefore shall her young men fall in the streets, and all her men of war shall be cut off in that day, saith the LORD.

³¹ Behold, I am against thee, O thou most proud, saith the Lord God of hosts: for thy day is come, the time that I will visit thee. (Most proud – Babylon, personified as pride itself)

³² And the most proud shall stumble and fall, and none shall raise him up: and I will kindle a fire in his cities, and it shall devour all round about him. (Who can prevail against God? No one can. Only a fool would even try)

³³ Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The children of Israel and the children of Judah were oppressed together: and all that took them captives held them fast; they refused to let them go. (God allowed Babylon to take Judah captive to destroy their evil country; not to destroy the people. Babylon went too far afterwards and oppressed the people)

³⁴ Their Redeemer is strong; the LORD of hosts is his name: he shall throughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon. (God sent Darius of Persia to defeat the Babylonians and free Israel and Judah; future - the Elect will stop the antichrist by witnessing in the end times, and Babel will end)

³⁵ A sword is upon the Chaldeans, saith the LORD, and upon the inhabitants of Babylon, and upon her princes, and upon her wise men. (Chaldeans = Babylonians) Revelation-1:15-16 (The sword is the Word of God. The truth destroys lies and confusion)

³⁶ A sword is upon the liars; and they shall dote: a sword is upon her mighty men; and they shall be dismayed. (When the truth of God is revealed, all peoples will see it)

³⁷ A sword is upon their horses, and upon their chariots, and upon all the mingled people that are in the midst of her; and they shall become as women: a sword is upon her treasures; and they shall be robbed. (They will not be able to defend themselves – because they have been deceived for so long that they think it is the truth. They think that antichrist is Jesus, returned)

³⁸ A drought is upon her waters; and they shall be dried up: for it is the land of graven images, and they are mad upon their idols. (They love their idols, still) (The drought is the lack of hearing the Word of God, properly taught)

³⁹ Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell there, and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation. (Babylon is destroyed. All people will bend the knee to Jesus Christ when He returns. In spiritual bodies all have total recall. Deception by antichrist is no longer possible because all people know what he is)

⁴⁰ As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah and the neighbour cities thereof, saith the LORD; so shall no man abide there, neither shall any son of man dwell therein. (Sodom and Gomorrah were also cities of perversion and idolatry. God destroyed them both. He didn't need the help of men)

⁴¹ Behold, a people shall come from the north, and a great nation, and many kings shall be raised up from the coasts of the earth.

⁴² They shall hold the bow and the lance: they are cruel, and will not shew mercy: their voice shall roar like the sea, and they shall ride upon horses, every one put in array, like a man to the battle, against thee, O daughter of Babylon. (Past: the Medes and the Persians; Future: Russia and the communists; maybe also the muslims?)

⁴³ The king of Babylon hath heard the report of them, and his hands waxed feeble: anguish took hold of him, and pangs as of a woman in travail. (When the truth comes out, antichrist will lose his hold on the deceived people. His one world system will collapse instantly as soon as Jesus returns)

⁴⁴ Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan unto the habitation of the strong: but I will make them suddenly run away from her: and who is a chosen man, that I may appoint over her? for who is like me? and who will appoint me the time? and who is that shepherd that will stand before me? (Jesus will be that shepherd – Jesus is God in the flesh – If you've seen Me, you've seen the Father)

⁴⁵ Therefore hear ye the counsel of the LORD, that he hath taken against Babylon; and his purposes, that he hath purposed against the land of the Chaldeans: Surely the least of the flock shall draw them out: surely he shall make their habitation desolate with them. (The least of the flock will be the Elect who are made to witness in the synagogue of antichrist, before the whole world. Their testimony will awaken many people because it is not them who speak but the holy Spirit of God) see Mark-13

⁴⁶At the noise of the taking of Babylon the earth is moved, and the cry is heard among the nations. (The deceived finally wake up and realize that they have been fooled. That is the end of antichrist and his deception) see Revelation-9
