

2 Timothy 2
King James Version (KJV)

2 Thou therefore, my son, be strong in the grace that is in Christ Jesus. (my spiritual son)

²And the things that thou hast heard of me among many witnesses, the same commit thou to faithful men, who shall be able to teach others also. (Pass the Word of God to others who are strong enough to teach correctly and boldly)

³Thou therefore endure hardness, as a good soldier of Jesus Christ. (The world hates Christians; always have and always will)

⁴No man that warreth entangleth himself with the affairs of this life; that he may please him who hath chosen him to be a soldier. (Don't let affairs of the world distract you in your fight against Satan)

⁵And if a man also strive for masteries, yet is he not crowned, except he strive lawfully. (Live within the law, do things legally and you will be allowed to teach God's Word)

⁶The husbandman that laboreth must be first partaker of the fruits. (God blesses His laborers)

⁷Consider what I say; and the Lord give thee understanding in all things. (Let God's Holy Spirit give you wisdom in understanding the scriptures) Isaiah-43:26

⁸Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel: (That is the essence of the New Testament. God came into the flesh, as Jesus, to defeat death and give salvation to all who believe on Him and repent)

⁹Wherein I suffer trouble, as an evil doer, even unto bonds; but the word of God is not bound. (Paul suffered at the hand of the Kenites because he taught the Word of God. The Kenites wanted him dead. So did the Jews who refused Jesus, and stuck to the old statutes and ordinances of Moses)

¹⁰Therefore I endure all things for the elect's sakes, that they may also obtain the salvation which is in Christ Jesus with eternal glory. (The Word of God has to be documented and passed down from generation to generation, until the end of this Age. At that time, the Elect, who have been taught, will stand against antichrist and testify before the whole world) Mark-13, Matthew-24

¹¹It is a faithful saying: For if we be dead with him, we shall also live with him: (Resurrection to immortality in the eternity)

¹²If we suffer, we shall also reign with him: if we deny him, he also will deny us: Luke-12:8-12 (If the Elect deny Christ, HE will deny them. That is the only unforgivable sin. The Elect know the truth. If they side with Satan, then that would be treason against God)

¹³If we believe not, yet he abideth faithful: he cannot deny himself. (God wants all people to come to repentance. HE is always faithful to us, upon repentance) Hebrews-13

¹⁴Of these things put them in remembrance, charging them before the Lord that they strive not about words to no profit, but to the subverting of the hearers. (Don't waste your time arguing with Bible lawyers and fake preachers. They twist words to deny Jesus. Focus on teaching the people)

¹⁵Study to shew thyself approved unto God, a workman that needeth not to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth. (Study God's Word, unchanged; not the traditions of men)

¹⁶But shun profane and vain babblings: for they will increase unto more ungodliness. (Most preachers today have no idea what they are teaching. They celebrate Easter, amongst other things)

¹⁷And their word will eat as doth a canker: of whom is Hymenaeus and Philetus; (canker = gangrene – better translation) (These two were false teachers who didn't believe that Jesus was God with us)

¹⁸Who concerning the truth have erred, saying that the resurrection is past already; and overthrow the faith of some. (Bad teachers drive people away from God)

¹⁹ Nevertheless the foundation of God standeth sure, having this seal, The Lord knoweth them that are his. And, let every one that nameth the name of Christ depart from iniquity. (These are the Christians <Christ men and women>) (Let the Holy Spirit seal God's Word in your mind) Deuteronomy 32:31-33 (Their rock is not our Rock. Christ is out foundation)

²⁰ But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour. (Vessels represent the deeds that people do. We all have duties to do for the brotherhood of Christianity)

²¹ If a man therefore purge himself from these, he shall be a vessel unto honour, sanctified, and meet for the master's use, and prepared unto every good work. (Separate yourself from the fake preachers that babble and teach traditions of men)

²² Flee also youthful lusts: but follow righteousness, faith, charity, peace, with them that call on the Lord out of a pure heart. (Stay away from the impulsive ways of the world. Analyze what a preacher says to see if it lines up with God's Word)

²³ But foolish and unlearned questions avoid, knowing that they do gender strifes. (avoid argument; stay in God's Word)

²⁴ And the servant of the Lord must not strive; but be gentle unto all men, apt to teach, patient, (No egoists should teach. You teach to help others, not to elevate yourself)

²⁵ In meekness instructing those that oppose themselves; if God peradventure will give them repentance to the acknowledging of the truth; (Plant a seed of truth. If it grows, that will not be up to you)

²⁶ And that they may recover themselves out of the snare of the devil, who are taken captive by him at his will. (If they learn from it, they might free themselves from the ways of the world)
