

Ezekiel 34

King James Version (KJV)

(Verses 1-16 are to the false shepherds. This is what to watch out for in the end times. Verses 17-22 are to the deceived flock and its leaders. Verses 23-31 are to the true Shepherd – Jesus Christ)

34 And the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,

²Son of man, prophesy against the shepherds of Israel, prophesy, and say unto them, Thus saith the Lord GOD unto the shepherds; Woe be to the shepherds of Israel that do feed themselves! should not the shepherds feed the flocks? (Fake preachers are in it for the money, and for ego; instead of feeding the Word of God to the flock) see Amos-8:11

³Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: but ye feed not the flock. (They don't teach the true Word of God. They teach traditions of men and false religion, so that their followers won't have a chance against the deceptions of the world and of antichrist when he arrives. They make themselves rich with tithes)

⁴The diseased have ye not strengthened, neither have ye healed that which was sick, neither have ye bound up that which was broken, neither have ye brought again that which was driven away, neither have ye sought that which was lost; but with force and with cruelty have ye ruled them. (Fire & brimstone preachers threaten with hellfire, yet they don't teach anything about the Word of God to their followers)

⁵And they were scattered, because there is no shepherd: and they became meat to all the beasts of the field, when they were scattered. (They were never taught the truth, so they believe whatever stories they are told by con artists and fake preachers. Most descendants of the 10 tribes today think that they are gentiles. They have lost their heritage)

⁶My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek after them. (They are the 10 tribes that went over the Caucasus Mountains, and settled Europe & America. <Caucasians> Today, most will tell you that they are gentiles, because they don't even know that they are descendants of the 10 northern tribes)

⁷Therefore, ye shepherds, hear the word of the LORD;

⁸As I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely because my flock became a prey, and my flock became meat to every beast of the field, because there was no shepherd, neither did my shepherds search for my flock, but the shepherds fed themselves, and fed not my flock; (Fake teachers, money grubbing preachers, who don't even understand God's Word) see Chapter-13:19-21

⁹Therefore, O ye shepherds, hear the word of the LORD;

¹⁰Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I am against the shepherds; and I will require my flock at their hand, and cause them to cease from feeding the flock; neither shall the shepherds feed themselves any more; for I will deliver my flock from their mouth, that they may not be meat for them. (In the end times, the Holy Spirit will prophecy against the antichrist through the Elect. Their testimony will awaken many people who were fooled with false doctrine) see chapter-13:19-20

¹¹For thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I, even I, will both search my sheep, and seek them out.

¹²As a shepherd seeketh out his flock in the day that he is among his sheep that are scattered; so will I seek out my sheep, and will deliver them out of all places where they have been scattered in the cloudy and dark day. (The days of false teaching and the days that antichrist is here)

¹³And I will bring them out from the people, and gather them from the countries, and will bring them to their own land, and feed them upon the mountains of Israel by the rivers, and in all the inhabited places of the country. (On the Lord's Day)

¹⁴I will feed them in a good pasture, and upon the high mountains of Israel shall their fold be: there shall they lie in a good fold, and in a fat pasture shall they feed upon the mountains of Israel. (God, Himself will do the feeding)

¹⁵I will feed my flock, and I will cause them to lie down, saith the Lord GOD. (They will be at peace under God's protection)

¹⁶I will seek that which was lost, and bring again that which was driven away, and will bind up that which was broken, and will strengthen that

which was sick: but I will destroy the fat and the strong; I will feed them with judgment. (The false shepherds have made themselves fat and strong)

¹⁷ And as for you, O my flock, thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I judge between cattle and cattle, between the rams and the he goats. (This is to the people that follow the false shepherds and profit by the false teaching) (God will judge between the good and the evil)

¹⁸ Seemeth it a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet? (They muddy up the water to pollute it so others cannot get a drink. False teachers cloud up the Word, and mistranslate it to confuse the people that are trying to learn from them)

¹⁹ And as for my flock, they eat that which ye have trodden with your feet; and they drink that which ye have fouled with your feet. (That's all that's left for them; muddy water is symbolic for false teaching which leads to confusion)

²⁰ Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD unto them; Behold, I, even I, will judge between the fat cattle and between the lean cattle.

²¹ Because ye have thrust with side and with shoulder, and pushed all the diseased with your horns, till ye have scattered them abroad; (No sympathy, no compassion; they push and climb over other people to get ahead)

²² Therefore will I save my flock, and they shall no more be a prey; and I will judge between cattle and cattle.

²³ And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, even my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd. (Christ is the Shepherd – David was an ancestor and is used as a type for Jesus) Psalms-23 (written by David)

²⁴ And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken it. (See chapter-46:1)

²⁵ And I will make with them a covenant of peace, and will cause the evil beasts to cease out of the land: and they shall dwell safely in the

wilderness, and sleep in the woods. (Normally, that would be unsafe. There will be no dangerous places left when Jesus returns)

²⁶ And I will make them and the places round about my hill a blessing; and I will cause the shower to come down in his season; there shall be showers of blessing.

²⁷ And the tree of the field shall yield her fruit, and the earth shall yield her increase, and they shall be safe in their land, and shall know that I am the LORD, when I have broken the bands of their yoke, and delivered them out of the hand of those that served themselves of them. (On the Lord's Day) (Today, any fake preacher or psychologist can make people feel good temporarily; but they don't learn anything about the Word of God. Only a true teacher of God's Word teaches people to know the Word and receive peace of mind)

²⁸ And they shall no more be a prey to the heathen, neither shall the beast of the land devour them; but they shall dwell safely, and none shall make them afraid. (the heathen= goy <Hebrew>; these are the Kenites. Sometimes they are called the small people)

²⁹ And I will raise up for them a plant of renown, and they shall be no more consumed with hunger in the land, neither bear the shame of the heathen any more. (The Messiah – the vine in many parables, the plant of renown here) (the heathen= goy <Hebrew> the Kenites)

³⁰ Thus shall they know that I the LORD their God am with them, and that they, even the house of Israel, are my people, saith the Lord God.

³¹ And ye my flock, the flock of my pasture, are men, and I am your God, saith the Lord God. (Men = Adam)
