- **Psalm 72** A Psalm for Solomon (A type for Messiah) King James Version (KJV) Probably written by King David)
- **72** Give the king thy judgments, O God, and thy righteousness unto the king's son. (Christ was also a direct descendent of David)
- ²He shall judge thy people with righteousness, and thy poor with judgment.
- ³The mountains shall bring peace to the people, and the little hills, by righteousness.
- ⁴He shall judge the <u>poor</u> of the people, he shall save the children of the needy, and shall break in pieces the <u>oppressor</u>. (poor= afflicted) (oppressor= the antichrist -> see Genesis-3:15)
- ⁵They shall fear thee as long as the sun and moon endure, throughout all generations. (All the way through to Revelation-21:23)
- ⁶He shall come down like rain upon the mown grass: as showers that water the earth. Hosea-6:3
- ⁷In his days shall the righteous flourish; and abundance of peace so long as the moon endureth. (The Millennium)
- ⁸He shall have dominion also from sea to sea, and from the river unto the ends of the earth. Zechariah-9:9-10
- They that dwell in the wilderness shall bow before him; and his enemies shall <u>lick the dust</u>. (lick the dust -> term of subjugation, degredation, shame)
- ¹⁰ The kings of <u>Tarshish</u> and of the isles shall bring presents: the kings of Sheba and Seba shall offer gifts. (<u>Tarshish</u> the bruisers) (<u>Sheba</u> on the East, Seba on the south -> both wealthy nations)
- ¹¹Yea, all kings shall fall down before him: all nations shall serve him.
- ¹² For he shall deliver the needy when he crieth; the poor also, and him that hath no helper.
- ¹³ He shall spare the poor and needy, and shall save the souls of the needy.

- ¹⁴ He shall redeem their soul from deceit and violence: and precious shall their blood be in his sight.
- ¹⁵ And he shall live, and to him shall be given of the gold of Sheba: prayer also shall be made for him continually; and daily shall he be praised.
- ¹⁶There shall be an <u>handful</u> of corn in the earth upon the top of the mountains; the fruit thereof shall shake like Lebanon: and they of the city shall flourish like grass of the earth. (handful= abundance)
- ¹⁷ His name shall endure for ever: his name shall be continued as long as the sun: and men shall be blessed in him: all nations shall call him blessed.
- ¹⁸ Blessed be the LORD God, the God of Israel, who only doeth wondrous things.
- ¹⁹ And blessed be his glorious name for ever: and let the whole earth be filled with his glory; Amen, and Amen.
- ²⁰ The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended. (All prophesies of David will be accomplished when this Psalm is realized The Millennium)
