King James Version (KJV)

Psalms are songs, prayers and prophecy

1 Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful. (Blessed – also means happy) (Don't follow sinners, help them and teach them. Don't become one of them)

²But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.

³And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.

⁴The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away. (Chaff– Thin covering of the grain of wheat. Not good for anything, weighs almost nothing, blows away with the wind)

⁵Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous. (Stand– rise, resurrect) Revelation-20:5-6

⁶For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.
