

Psalm 29

A Psalm of David -Yahoveh's storm

King James Version (KJV)

29 Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength. (mighty= sons of God. The angels)

²Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name; worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness.

³The voice of the LORD is upon the waters: the God of glory thundereth: the LORD is upon many waters. (thundereth= thunder, but also any low pitch, loud rumbling...earthquake, tornado, etc)

⁴The voice of the LORD is powerful; the voice of the LORD is full of majesty.

⁵The voice of the LORD breaketh the cedars; yea, the LORD breaketh the cedars of Lebanon.

⁶He maketh them also to skip like a calf; Lebanon and Sirion like a young unicorn. (unicorn= wild ox or bull) (Sirion= Mt. Hermon)

⁷The voice of the LORD divideth the flames of fire.

⁸The voice of the LORD shaketh the wilderness; the LORD shaketh the wilderness of Kadesh.

⁹The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of his glory.

¹⁰The LORD sitteth upon the flood; yea, the LORD sitteth King for ever. (flood= specifically the flood of Noah, in the Hebrew) (Prophetically – the flood of lies from Satan)

¹¹The LORD will give strength unto his people; the LORD will bless his people with peace.

Psalms 26 -> 29 were written when David was escaping Absalom to avoid a civil war.
