Psalm 33 (some believe this is a continuation of Ps-32) King James Version (KJV)

- **33** Rejoice in the LORD, O ye righteous: for praise is comely for the upright.
- ² Praise the LORD with harp: sing unto him with the psaltery and an instrument of ten strings.
- ³ Sing unto him a new song; play skillfully with a loud noise.
- ⁴ For the word of the LORD is right; and all his works are done in truth.
- ⁵He loveth righteousness and judgment: the earth is full of the goodness of the LORD.
- ⁶ By the word of the LORD were the heavens made; and all the host of them by the breath of his mouth.
- ⁷He gathereth the waters of the sea together as an heap: he layeth up the <u>depth in storehouses</u>. (underground waters)
- *Let all the earth <u>fear</u> the LORD: let all the inhabitants of the world stand in awe of him. (fear= fear or revere)
- ⁹ For he spake, and it was done; he commanded, and it stood fast.
- ¹⁰ The LORD bringeth the counsel of the heathen to nought: he maketh the <u>devices</u> of the people of none effect. (devices= plans)
- ¹¹ The counsel of the LORD standeth for ever, the thoughts of his heart to all generations.
- ¹² Blessed is the nation whose God is the LORD; and the people whom he hath chosen for his own inheritance. See Ex-19:5, Deut-7:6
- ¹³ The LORD looketh from heaven; he beholdeth all the sons of men.
- ¹⁴ From the place of his habitation he looketh upon all the inhabitants of the earth.
- ¹⁵ He fashioneth their hearts alike; he considereth all their works.
- ¹⁶There is no king saved by the multitude of an host: a mighty man is not delivered by much strength.

- ¹⁷ An horse is a vain thing for safety: neither shall he deliver any by his great strength.
- ¹⁸ Behold, the eye of the LORD is upon them that fear him, upon them that hope in his mercy; (fear= revere same word in Hebrew)
- ¹⁹ To deliver their soul from death, and to keep them alive in <u>famine</u>. Amos-8:11
- ²⁰ Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he is our help and our shield. (The true Christ comes after the antichrist)
- ²¹ For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name.
- ²² Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.
