

Psalm 94

King James Version (KJV)

94 O Lord God, to whom vengeance belongeth; O God, to whom vengeance belongeth, shew thyself. **Deteronomy-32:35, Nahum-1-2**

²Lift up thyself, thou judge of the earth: render a reward to the proud. **(Pride was Satan's sin, and his downfall)**

³LORD, how long shall the wicked, how long shall the wicked triumph?

⁴How long shall they utter and speak hard things? and all the workers of iniquity boast themselves? **(hard- arrogant)**

⁵They break in pieces thy people, O LORD, and afflict thine heritage.

⁶They slay the widow and the stranger, and murder the fatherless.

⁷Yet they say, The LORD shall not see, neither shall the God of Jacob regard it.

⁸Understand, ye brutish among the people: and ye fools, when will ye be wise? **(brutish- stupid, also beastlike, crude) Proverbs-1:7**

⁹He that planted the ear, shall he not hear? he that formed the eye, shall he not see?

¹⁰He that chastiseth the heathen, shall not he correct? he that teacheth man knowledge, shall not he know?

¹¹The LORD knoweth the thoughts of man, that they are vanity.

¹²Blessed is the man whom thou chastenest, O LORD, and teachest him out of thy law;

¹³That thou mayest give him rest from the days of adversity, until the pit be digged for the wicked. **(12 & 13 are one thought, connected by semi-colon)**

¹⁴For the LORD will not cast off his people, neither will he forsake his inheritance.

¹⁵But judgment shall return unto righteousness: and all the upright in heart shall follow it.

¹⁶ Who will rise up for me against the evildoers? or who will stand up for me against the workers of iniquity? (the Elect will testify against antichrist, before Christ's return)

¹⁷ Unless the LORD had been my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.

¹⁸ When I said, My foot slippeth; thy mercy, O LORD, held me up.

¹⁹ In the multitude of my thoughts within me thy comforts delight my soul. (God's Word keeps us focused on what is really important)

²⁰ Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law? (throne of iniquity – the throne of Satan) (Psalm 91 shows how Satan twists Gods Word to make it a lie)

²¹ They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous, and condemn the innocent blood. (They can accuse, but they can't harm your soul, unless you let them deceive you)

²² But the LORD is my defence; and my God is the rock of my refuge.
Romans-8:31

²³ And he shall bring upon them their own iniquity, and shall cut them off in their own wickedness; yea, the LORD our God shall cut them off.
