A Song of Degrees

King James Version (KJV)

130 Out of the depths have I cried unto thee, O LORD.

²Lord, hear my voice: let thine ears be attentive to the voice of my supplications.

³If thou, LORD, shouldest mark iniquities, O Lord, who shall stand?
(Which of us hasn't sinned – other than Jesus)

⁴But there is forgiveness with thee, that thou mayest be feared. (But there is forgiveness upon repentance) (feared= revered) Isaiah-38:17

⁵I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.
(hope- trust, believe)

⁶My soul waiteth for the Lord more than they that watch for the morning: I say, more than they that watch for the morning.

⁷Let Israel hope in the LORD: for with the LORD there is mercy, and with him is plenteous redemption.

⁸And he shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities. Romans-11:26
