A Song of Degrees

King James Version (KJV)

132 Lord, remember David, and all his afflictions:

²How he swore unto the LORD, and vowed unto the mighty God of Jacob;

³Surely I will not come into the tabernacle of my house, nor go up into my bed;

⁴I will not give sleep to mine eyes, or slumber to mine eyelids,

⁵Until I find out a place for the LORD, an habitation for the mighty God of Jacob. [Acts-7:46](#)

⁶Lo, we heard of it at Ephratah: we found it in the fields of the wood. [\(Where the Ark was located in Shiloh, Also when it was taken by the Philistines, and then returned to Israel\)](#)

⁷We will go into his tabernacles: we will worship at his footstool.

⁸Arise, O LORD, into thy rest; thou, and the ark of thy strength.

⁹Let thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let thy saints shout for joy. [\(Let their conduct be worthy of the LORD\) 1Peter-4:17](#) [\(saints- the Elect\)](#)

¹⁰For thy servant David's sake turn not away the face of thine anointed. [2Samuel-7:12-13 \(God's promise to David, ending with Jesus Christ- the King for ever\)](#)

¹¹The LORD hath sworn in truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.

¹²If thy children will keep my covenant and my testimony that I shall teach them, their children shall also sit upon thy throne for evermore. [\(Zedekiah's daughters went to Britain, and still sit on that throne, today.\) \(They didn't meet the "IF" requirement, therefore, Jesus assumed the throne of Israel, forever\)](#)

¹³For the LORD hath chosen Zion; he hath desired it for his habitation. [Ezekiel-16:8](#)

¹⁴This is my rest for ever: here will I dwell; for I have desired it.

¹⁵ I will abundantly bless her provision: I will satisfy her poor with bread. (Jesus is the Bread of life)

¹⁶ I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy. (This will happen on the Lord's Day) Reference -> Ezekiel-44, Revelation-20

¹⁷ There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed. (Jesus is the light of the world)

¹⁸ His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish. (The enemies of Jesus Christ – on the Lord's Day)

When David brought up the Ark from Kirjath-Jarim to Jerusalem. Here, Hezekiah still has no heir, and is reminding God of His promise to continue the king line through David's progeny.
