

## Ezekiel 8

King James Version (KJV)

**8** And it came to pass in the sixth year, in the sixth month, in the fifth day of the month, as I sat in mine house, and the elders of Judah sat before me, that the hand of the Lord GOD fell there upon me. **(The elders of Jerusalem came to Ezekiel's house for advice)**

<sup>2</sup>Then I beheld, and lo a likeness as the appearance of fire: from the appearance of his loins even downward, fire; and from his loins even upward, as the appearance of brightness, as the colour of amber.

<sup>3</sup>And he put forth the form of an hand, and took me by a lock of mine head; and the spirit lifted me up between the earth and the heaven, and brought me in the visions of God to Jerusalem, to the door of the inner gate that looketh toward the north; where was the seat of the image of jealousy, which provoketh to jealousy. **(Isaiah-14 - God's throne will be on the north side at the 7<sup>th</sup> trump – the judgment seat. Also this is where Satan is jealous of Jesus and will also set up his throne on the north side when he comes as antichrist at the 6<sup>th</sup> trump)**

<sup>4</sup>And, behold, the glory of the God of Israel was there, according to the vision that I saw in the plain. **(This will happen at the Third Age)**

<sup>5</sup>Then said he unto me, Son of man, lift up thine eyes now the way toward the north. So I lifted up mine eyes the way toward the north, and behold northward at the gate of the altar this image of jealousy in the entry. **(Satan is there and people are swooning before him. This is the jealousy that is spoken of here)**

<sup>6</sup>He said furthermore unto me, Son of man, seest thou what they do? even the great abominations that the house of Israel committeth here, that I should go far off from my sanctuary? but turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations.

<sup>7</sup>And he brought me to the door of the court; and when I looked, behold a hole in the wall.

<sup>8</sup>Then said he unto me, Son of man, dig now in the wall: and when I had digged in the wall, behold a door. **(Something covered or hidden going on behind the door)**

<sup>9</sup>And he said unto me, Go in, and behold the wicked abominations that they do here.

<sup>10</sup> So I went in and saw; and behold every form of creeping things, and abominable beasts, and all the idols of the house of Israel, pourtrayed upon the wall round about. (False teachings and traditions of men, in the House of God – Eve eating an apple, Easter, who the Kenites are, homosexuality, pedophilia, human sacrifice to false deities and other perversions)

<sup>11</sup> And there stood before them seventy men of the ancients of the house of Israel, and in the midst of them stood Jaazaniah the son of Shaphan, with every man his censer in his hand; and a thick cloud of incense went up. (Jaazaniah = heard of Yah; Shaphan = conies or rabbits, like an Easter bunny; each had a censer in his hand - these guys are priests, who are not teaching the true Word of God. They sure know how to make it all look so holy)

<sup>12</sup> Then said he unto me, Son of man, hast thou seen what the ancients of the house of Israel do in the dark, every man in the chambers of his imagery? for they say, the LORD seeth us not; the LORD hath forsaken the earth. (They think God doesn't see what they are doing)

<sup>13</sup> He said also unto me, Turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations that they do.

<sup>14</sup> Then he brought me to the door of the gate of the LORD's house which was toward the north; and, behold, there sat women weeping for Tammuz. (Tammuz = sprout of life – a goddess over animals, agricultural life and obscene rites. She was worshipped along with Ishtar the goddess of heaven and of fertility) (Today, Christians still celebrate Easter <Easter bunny, rolling eggs of fertility, sunrise services, etc> this is an abomination to God. God told us to celebrate Passover, not Easter)

<sup>15</sup> Then said he unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? turn thee yet again, and thou shalt see greater abominations than these. (How can it get any worse?)

<sup>16</sup> And he brought me into the inner court of the LORD's house, and, behold, at the door of the temple of the LORD, between the porch and the altar, were about five and twenty men, with their backs toward the temple of the LORD, and their faces toward the east; and they worshipped the sun toward the east. 2Kings-23:5-10 (Sun worshippers right there in the temple of God – with their backs to God's altar – worshipping the sunrise) (Easter "services" occur today, at sunrise, facing East as well)

<sup>17</sup> Then he said unto me, Hast thou seen this, O son of man? Is it a light thing to the house of Judah that they commit the abominations which they commit here? for they have filled the land with violence, and have returned to provoke me to anger: and, lo, they put the branch to their nose. (The branch= Ashteroth – wooden male phallic symbol representing human fertility – this was all connected to Ishtar worship and the orgies in the groves)

<sup>18</sup> Therefore will I also deal in fury: mine eye shall not spare, neither will I have pity: and though they cry in mine ears with a loud voice, yet will I not hear them. (God will judge them for their abominations)
