

## **Psalm 101**

## A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

**101** I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD, will I sing.

<sup>2</sup>I will behave myself wisely in a perfect way. O when wilt thou come unto me? I will walk within my house with a perfect heart. (perfect- well intentioned, mature) (perfect- moral innocence)

<sup>3</sup>I will set no wicked thing before mine eyes: I hate the work of them that turn aside; it shall not cleave to me.

<sup>4</sup>A froward heart shall depart from me: I will not know a wicked person. (forward- perverse)

<sup>5</sup>Whoso privily slandereth his neighbour, him will I cut off: him that hath an high look and a proud heart will not I suffer. (suffer- tolerate, endure, accept) Proverbs-6:16

<sup>6</sup>Mine eyes shall be upon the faithful of the land, that they may dwell with me: he that walketh in a perfect way, he shall serve me. (perfect- mature, upright, with integrity)

<sup>7</sup>He that worketh deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that telleth lies shall not tarry in my sight.

<sup>8</sup>I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD. (At Judgment Day)
