## 1 Corinthians 6 King James Version (KJV)

- **6** Dare any of you, having a matter against another, go to law before the unjust, and not before the saints? (Try to work out a disagreement amongst yourselves, before running to a court of law. Courts are run by the heathen and rule by precedent, instead of righteousness. The lawyers will reap the rewards and you both will lose)
- <sup>2</sup>Do ye not know that the saints shall judge the world? and if the world shall be judged by you, are ye unworthy to judge the smallest matters? Ezekiel-44:23-24 (The Elect will teach discernment during the Millennium)
- <sup>3</sup>Know ye not that we shall judge <u>angels</u>? how much more things that pertain to this life? (angels- people will be in their spiritual bodies, as angels are today; all flesh will be gone when the Millennium begins)
- <sup>4</sup>If then ye have judgments of things pertaining to this life, set them to judge who are least esteemed in the church. (Work out your differences within the group, not in courts of law)
- <sup>5</sup>I speak to your shame. Is it so, that there is not a wise man among you? no, not one that shall be able <u>to judge</u> between his brethren? (to judge to arbitrate between two parties who have a disagreement, using God's law of good vs. evil; not by precedent like civilian courts)
- <sup>6</sup>But brother goeth to law with brother, and that before the unbelievers. (Atheist judges rule be precedent, whether it is right or wrong. They have no choice)
- <sup>7</sup>Now therefore there is utterly a fault among you, because ye go to law one with another. Why do ye not rather take wrong? why do ye not rather suffer yourselves to be defrauded? (Better to lose a little now, than a lot later by going before a court with lawyers and other fees Common sense)
- \*Nay, ye do wrong, and defraud, and that your brethren. (You lack charity and justice between each other)

- <sup>9</sup>Know ye not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor <u>effeminate</u>, nor abusers of themselves with mankind, (effeminate = gays) Romans-1:27 (Homosexuality is a perversion; not a lifestyle. Repent receive forgiveness and live a good healthy life)
- <sup>10</sup> Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor <u>revilers</u>, nor extortioners, shall inherit the kingdom of God. (<u>revilers</u> = trouble makers)
- <sup>11</sup>And such were some of you: but ye are washed, but ye are sanctified, but ye are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God. (When you repent, your sins are washed away)
- <sup>12</sup>All things are lawful unto me, but all things are not expedient: all things are lawful for me, but I will not be brought under the power of any. (Obey God's Law, not traditions of men that enslave people usury, debt, addictions)
- <sup>13</sup> Meats for the belly, and the belly for meats: but God shall destroy both it and them. Now the body is not for fornication, but for the Lord; and the Lord for the body. (Flesh is only temporary. We have two bodies our flesh body that will grow old and die, and our spiritual body which can become immortal if we make the cut at judgment day)
- "And God hath both raised up the Lord, and will also raise up us by his own power. (Our eternal <spiritual> bodies; when people say they saw an angel that is merely a person in their spiritual body. Either they haven't been born in the flesh yet, or they already lived and died in the flesh)
- <sup>16</sup>Know ye not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid. (Don't abase yourself with the vices of the world lusty sex, drugs, booze, gambling, debt, sin)
- <sup>16</sup>What? know ye not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, saith he, shall be one flesh. (Marry someone who has the same Christian values that you do)

<sup>17</sup>But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit. (Join God, spiritually, and gain His holiness)

<sup>18</sup> Flee fornication. Every sin that a man doeth is without the body; but he that committeth fornication sinneth against his own body. (Look at the western countries today – with the "new morality", and the politically correct inclusion of sexual perverts and drug users)

<sup>19</sup> What? know ye not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which ye have of God, and ye are not your own? (God owns all souls. Treat your body like it's a temple of God, because it is) Ezekiel-18:4

<sup>20</sup> For ye are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's. (The Father created us. Jesus redeemed us on the cross. We belong to God)
