

## John 14

King James Version (KJV)

**14** Let not your heart be troubled: ye believe in God, believe also in me.

<sup>2</sup>In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. (mansion = Mone<Greek>; Mansion = a resting place – better translation; Our rest is in Jesus)

<sup>3</sup>And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will come again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also. (Jesus will return at the Second Advent as Lord of lords, King of kings)

<sup>4</sup>And whither I go ye know, and the way ye know. Ecclesiastes-12:6-7, Psalms-22, Isaiah-7:14

<sup>5</sup>Thomas saith unto him, Lord, we know not whither thou goest; and how can we know the way? (Jesus taught them over and over that HE is the way; He is the way to salvation)

<sup>6</sup>Jesus saith unto him, I am the way, the truth, and the life: no man cometh unto the Father, but by me. (Christianity is the only way to salvation and eternal life with God)

<sup>7</sup>If ye had known me, ye should have known my Father also: and from henceforth ye know him, and have seen him.

<sup>8</sup>Philip saith unto him, Lord, show us the Father, and it sufficeth us.

<sup>9</sup>Jesus saith unto him, Have I been so long time with you, and yet hast thou not known me, Philip? he that hath seen me hath seen the Father; and how sayest thou then, Show us the Father? Isaiah-7:14 (Jesus is God in the flesh. Not His "son" but rather His begotten. God came to us as a flesh man, through Mary)

(You either believe it or you don't. There is no in-between. In Genesis-1:26, God made Jesus in His image and we made our flesh bodies in our image. When our flesh body dies, we return to our spiritual body)

<sup>10</sup>Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that

dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. (dwelleth- this is the same word as mansion in the Greek)

<sup>11</sup> Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. (The many miracles that Jesus performed in their sight)

<sup>12</sup> Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. (Today, with communications technology, we can instantly easily reach the whole world with the Word of God)

<sup>13</sup> And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name, that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. (When we are doing God's works)

<sup>14</sup> If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. (When we are doing God's work)

<sup>15</sup> If ye love me, keep my commandments. (All Ten Commandments)

<sup>16</sup> And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; (The Holy Spirit of God; this is another of God's offices)

<sup>17</sup> Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. (The ways of the world are contrary to the ways of God. That's why the world cannot see God's Spirit)

<sup>18</sup> I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. (Jesus is God, as is His Holy Spirit. One God, many offices)

<sup>19</sup> Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also. (If you believe, God will give you eternal life in the Third Age)

<sup>20</sup> At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you. (One family in God)

<sup>21</sup> He that hath my commandments, and keepeth them, he it is that loveth me: and he that loveth me shall be loved of my Father, and I will love him, and will manifest myself to him. (Knowing the commandments isn't enough; you have to do them)

<sup>22</sup> Judas saith unto him, not Iscariot, Lord, how is it that thou wilt manifest thyself unto us, and not unto the world? (They still don't get it)

<sup>23</sup> Jesus answered and said unto him, If a man love me, he will keep my words: and my Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. (abode – this is the same word as mansion) also see Psalms-91:1-16

<sup>24</sup> He that loveth me not keepeth not my sayings: and the word which ye hear is not mine, but the Father's which sent me. John-1:1

<sup>25</sup> These things have I spoken unto you, being yet present with you.

<sup>26</sup> But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you. (Holy Ghost = Holy Spirit = Neuma <Greek> - this is a bad translation; God is not a spook. HE has a spirit just like we do)

<sup>27</sup> Peace I leave with you, my peace I give unto you: not as the world giveth, give I unto you. Let not your heart be troubled, neither let it be afraid. (Christ brings peace of mind and spiritual comfort)

<sup>28</sup> Ye have heard how I said unto you, I go away, and come again unto you. If ye loved me, ye would rejoice, because I said, I go unto the Father: for my Father is greater than I. (Jesus is God, but He is in the flesh. Our flesh bodies limit our abilities)

<sup>29</sup> And now I have told you before it come to pass, that, when it is come to pass, ye might believe.

<sup>30</sup> Hereafter I will not talk much with you: for the prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me. (That is Satan)

<sup>31</sup> But that the world may know that I love the Father; and as the Father gave me commandment, even so I do. Arise, let us go hence. Hebrews-2:14-15 (Jesus will continue to do good work. When Satan has Him crucified, he is signing his own death warrant for murder. That's why Jesus allowed it. Satan started the conflict; and God will finish it, permanently)
