Isaiah 59

King James Version (KJV)

- **59** Behold, the LORD's hand is not shortened, that it cannot save; neither his ear heavy, that it cannot hear: (God is not weak, nor is HE deaf)
- ²But your iniquities have separated between you and your God, and your sins have hid his face from you, that he will not hear. (Our sins cause the separation; sinners leave God, HE doesn't leave them)
- ³ For your hands are defiled with blood, and your fingers with iniquity; your lips have spoken lies, your tongue hath muttered perverseness. (Go against God's Word and evil walks right in. Taking God's Word out of our schools and our government has caused us to spiral downward, morally. Look at the world today; rampant abortions, gang violence, gay marriage, false religion, atheism, lying and corrupt government officials, crooked judges)
- *None calleth for justice, nor any pleadeth for truth: they trust in vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity. (The courts are bought and paid for by the rich and corrupt) (vanity=tuhu in the Hebrew vanity, emptiness; same word as in Genesis-1:2) (Iniquity = sin, trespass)
- ⁵They hatch cockatrice' eggs, and weave the spider's web: he that eateth of their eggs dieth, and that which is crushed breaketh out into a viper. (cockatrice= serpents; spider's web a web of lies and deceit) (Stay away from Satan and the Kenites)
- ⁶Their webs shall not become garments, neither shall they cover themselves with their works: their works are works of iniquity, and the act of violence is in their hands. (False teaching and lies won't get you a place in heaven, nor the robes made with fine linens of our righteous acts and our good works) Revalation-19:7-8
- ⁷Their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed innocent blood: their thoughts are thoughts of iniquity; wasting and destruction are in their paths. (Physically- crime & destruction; spiritually- false teaching and confusion)
- The way of peace they know not; and there is no judgment in their goings: they have made them crooked paths: whosoever goeth therein

shall not know peace. (Follow man and you will be lost. Follow God, learn the truth and no one can ever deceive you)

(Most churches today read one verse of God's Word, and then go into a 1 hour sermon written by some preacher. That is not what God wants from us. HE wants us to learn His Word, chapter by chapter, verse by verse. Men's sermons are traditions of men. They are worthless in God's eyes)

- Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, but we walk in darkness. (This is the result of following false teachings confusion, darkness; things don't fit together well; you think that you see contradictions in Christianity)
- ¹⁰ We grope for the wall like the blind, and we grope as if we had no eyes: we stumble at noon day as in the night; we are in desolate places as dead men. (Spiritually dead, unable to see the truth)
- ¹¹ We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but there is none; for salvation, but it is far off from us. (Because of the breach between themselves and God)
- ¹² For our transgressions are multiplied before thee, and our sins testify against us: for our transgressions are with us; and as for our iniquities, we know them;
- ¹³ In transgressing and lying against the LORD, and departing away from our God, speaking oppression and revolt, conceiving and uttering from the heart words of falsehood. (Those who become an enemy of God, with false religion, islam or atheism)
- ¹⁴ And judgment is turned away backward, and justice standeth afar off: for truth is fallen in the street, and equity cannot enter.
- ¹⁵Yea, truth faileth; and he that departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw it, and it displeased him that there was no judgment. (No judgment for true justice. If someone tries to leave the deception and get right with God, the rest of them go after him to destroy him. In islam, they actually murder anyone who tries to leave)
- ¹⁶ And he saw that there was no man, and wondered that there was no intercessor: therefore his arm brought salvation unto him; and his

- righteousness, it sustained him. (God came to us as Jesus Christ to set things right for us. If we believe and follow Him, He saves us)
- ¹⁷ For he put on righteousness as a breastplate, and an helmet of salvation upon his head; and he put on the garments of vengeance for clothing, and was clad with zeal as a cloak. (This is the gospel armor as Paul stated in Ephesians. Spiritually speaking, Christ will war with Satan and all evil)
- ¹⁸ According to their deeds, accordingly he will repay, fury to his adversaries, recompence to his enemies; to the islands he will repay recompence. (Everyone everywhere will get just what they deserve)
- ¹⁹ So shall they fear the name of the LORD from the west, and his glory from the rising of the sun. When the enemy shall come in like a flood, the Spirit of the LORD shall lift up a standard against him. (The standard is our Lord Jesus Christ)
- ²⁰ And the Redeemer shall come to Zion, and unto them that turn from transgression in Jacob, saith the LORD. (Christ is the kinsman Redeemer of all Christians)
- ²¹ As for me, this is my covenant with them, saith the LORD; My spirit that is upon thee, and my words which I have put in thy mouth, shall not depart out of thy mouth, nor out of the mouth of thy seed, nor out of the mouth of thy seed's seed, saith the LORD, from henceforth and for ever. (God provides a remnant to teach the truth of His Word from generation to generation) Romans-11
