

Isaiah 64

King James Version (KJV)

(A prayer to God)

64 Oh that thou wouldest rend the heavens, that thou wouldest come down, that the mountains might flow down at thy presence, (Asking for God's return)

²As when the melting fire burneth, the fire causeth the waters to boil, to make thy name known to thine adversaries, that the nations may tremble at thy presence! (When Jesus returns, all nations will know Him)

³When thou didst terrible things which we looked not for, thou camest down, the mountains flowed down at thy presence. (terrible= awesome) Jeremiah-4:18, 2Peter-3 (This was the destruction of the First Age. We are in the Second Age)

⁴For since the beginning of the world men have not heard, nor perceived by the ear, neither hath the eye seen, O God, beside thee, what he hath prepared for him that waiteth for him. (Those who wait for the true Messiah at the 7th trump will receive His blessings. The false messiah comes at the 6th trump)

⁵Thou meetest him that rejoiceth and worketh righteousness, those that remember thee in thy ways: behold, thou art wroth; for we have sinned: in those is continuance, and we shall be saved. (Because Jesus provided the way to salvation)

⁶But we are all as an unclean thing, and all our righteousnesses are as filthy rags; and we all do fade as a leaf; and our iniquities, like the wind, have taken us away. (Our existence in the flesh is very temporary)

⁷And there is none that calleth upon thy name, that stirreth up himself to take hold of thee: for thou hast hid thy face from us, and hast consumed us, because of our iniquities. (They don't call on God so He doesn't call on them. They need to repent to get back in His grace)

⁸But now, O LORD, thou art our father; we are the clay, and thou our potter; and we all are the work of thy hand. (LORD = Yahoveh)

(600 years later, Judas sold Jesus to the Kenite chief priest for 30 pieces of silver. He later repented and threw the silver on the floor in

the temple. The Kenites took the 30 pieces of silver and bought the potter's field. They also murdered Judas to keep him from talking. Even the enemies of God will fulfill His plan whether they like it or not)

⁹ Be not wroth very sore, O LORD, neither remember iniquity for ever: behold, see, we beseech thee, we are all thy people. (These are the 10 northern tribes of Israel. Most of them don't even know who they are today. They call themselves gentiles)

¹⁰ Thy holy cities are a wilderness, Zion is a wilderness, Jerusalem a desolation. (This will happen when the antichrist defiles it) see 2Thessalonians-2:4, Mark-13, Mathew-24 and Luke-21

¹¹ Our holy and our beautiful house, where our fathers praised thee, is burned up with fire: and all our pleasant things are laid waste. (By antichrist and the Kenites when he stands in Jerusalem, claiming to be Jesus, returned. Most of the world will believe him and worship him)

¹² Wilt thou refrain thyself for these things, O LORD? wilt thou hold thy peace, and afflict us very sore? (Asking God to bring on the end of this age so we can go into the Millennium)
