## Isaiah 54

King James Version (KJV)

- **54** Sing, O <u>barren</u>, thou that didst not bear; break forth into singing, and cry aloud, thou that didst not travail with child: for more are the children of the desolate than the children of the married wife, saith the LORD. (barren Luke 23:28) (Spiritually speaking- The barren are not seduced by the antichrist, in the end times. The barren wait for the return of the true Messiah <the bridegroom>, on the 7<sup>th</sup> trump) Also see Mark-13
- <sup>2</sup>Enlarge the place of thy tent, and let them stretch forth the curtains of thine habitations: spare not, lengthen thy cords, and strengthen thy stakes; (The barren will be blessed, and will need to enlarge their tents for the great bounty that God will provide)
- <sup>3</sup> For thou shalt break forth on the right hand and on the left; and thy seed shall inherit the <u>Gentiles</u>, and make the desolate cities to be inhabited. (Gentiles = nations) (Many gentiles will be converted in the Millennium)
- Fear not; for thou shalt not be ashamed: neither be thou confounded; for thou shalt not be put to shame: for thou shalt forget the shame of thy youth, and shalt not remember the reproach of thy widowhood any more. Revelation-18:7 (The falseness of Babylon; she says she is no widow, but a queen, seduced by antichrist)
- <sup>5</sup> For thy Maker is thine husband; the LORD of hosts is his name; and thy Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called. (This is the great marriage- Spiritually speaking)
- For the LORD hath called thee as a woman forsaken and grieved in spirit, and a wife of youth, when thou wast refused, saith thy God. (During the great apostasy, some may feel forsaken; but they aren't)
- <sup>7</sup>For a small moment have I forsaken thee; but with great mercies will I gather thee. (HE gives the false Christ the time to test those that want to be deceived at the 6<sup>th</sup> trump, but then HE returns at the 7<sup>th</sup> trump)
- In a little wrath I hid my face from thee for a moment; but with everlasting kindness will I have mercy on thee, saith the LORD thy Redeemer. (During the short season of antichrist)

- <sup>9</sup> For this is as the waters of Noah unto me: for as I have sworn that the waters of Noah should no more go over the earth; so have I sworn that I would not be wroth with thee, nor rebuke thee. Genesis-9:13 (God gave us the rainbow as a reminder of His promise of no more floods; and that HE would not abandon those who follow Him)
- <sup>10</sup> For the mountains shall depart, and the hills be removed; but my kindness shall not depart from thee, neither shall the covenant of my peace be removed, saith the LORD that hath mercy on thee. (Mountains & hills are countries and governments)
- <sup>11</sup>O thou afflicted, tossed with tempest, and not comforted, behold, I will lay thy stones with fair colours, and lay thy foundations with sapphires. Revelation-21:18
- <sup>12</sup> And I will make thy windows of agates, and thy gates of carbuncles, and all thy borders of pleasant stones.
- <sup>13</sup> And all thy children shall be taught of the LORD; and great shall be the peace of thy children. (In the Millennium, all will be taught the truth) (Today, the Word of God has been removed from schools and there is no peace)
- <sup>14</sup>In righteousness shalt thou be established: thou shalt be far from oppression; for thou shalt not fear: and from terror; for it shall not come near thee. (Terrorists won't be there)
- <sup>15</sup> Behold, they shall surely gather together, but not by me: whosoever shall gather together against thee shall fall for thy sake. (Antichrist will gather the deceived and the wicked, against the Christians. They will fail)
- <sup>16</sup> Behold, I have created the smith that bloweth the coals in the fire, and that bringeth forth an instrument for his work; and I have created the waster to destroy. (Even Satan is subject to God. He keeps Satan around to test us in this life. Do we choose good or evil?)
- <sup>17</sup>No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, saith the LORD. Luke-10:18 (God gave us power over all our enemies; don't back down)
