

Isaiah 6

King James Version (KJV)

6 In the year that king Uzziah died I saw also the LORD sitting upon a throne, high and lifted up, and his train filled the temple. (A vision of God; God is speaking to us from His temple)

²Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly. (This is similar to the vision that Ezekiel saw)

³And one cried unto another, and said, Holy, holy, holy, is the LORD of hosts: the whole earth is full of his glory.

⁴And the posts of the door moved at the voice of him that cried, and the house was filled with smoke. (God was present there)

⁵Then said I, Woe is me! for I am undone; because I am a man of unclean lips, and I dwell in the midst of a people of unclean lips: for mine eyes have seen the King, the LORD of hosts. (Isaiah felt not worthy to stand in the presence of God)

⁶Then flew one of the seraphims unto me, having a live coal in his hand, which he had taken with the tongs from off the altar: (This is the altar of God)

⁷And he laid it upon my mouth, and said, Lo, this hath touched thy lips; and thine iniquity is taken away, and thy sin purged. (The coal did not burn him. God purified Isaiah's mouth to speak for Him)

⁸Also I heard the voice of the Lord, saying, Whom shall I send, and who will go for us? Then said I, Here am I; send me.

⁹And he said, Go, and tell this people, Hear ye indeed, but understand not; and see ye indeed, but perceive not. (They just don't get it. God was trying to wake them up)

¹⁰Make the heart of this people fat, and make their ears heavy, and shut their eyes; lest they see with their eyes, and hear with their ears, and understand with their heart, and convert, and be healed. (A sin committed in ignorance is no sin. The spirit of stupor in this life will allow them to be taught in the Millennium. Maybe they will be saved at that time)

¹¹ Then said I, Lord, how long? And he answered, Until the cities be wasted without inhabitant, and the houses without man, and the land be utterly desolate, (Desolate – caused by the coming of the desolator) (Spiritually, most people know nothing of what the Bible teaches – Satan comes first to deceive all, and then, Jesus comes)

¹² And the LORD have removed men far away, and there be a great forsaking in the midst of the land. (The great apostasy; most people will follow antichrist)

¹³ But yet in it shall be a tenth, and it shall return, and shall be eaten: as a teil tree, and as an oak, whose substance is in them, when they cast their leaves: so the holy seed shall be the substance thereof. (substance = a monumental stone – stationary, steady, unshakable and stands for something) (This is the Elect, standing strong) (If you cut down a teil or an oak tree, a new shoot will spring back out of the trunk and the tree will re-grow)
