Habakkuk 1

King James Version (KJV)

(Habakkuk = to embrace; be careful who you embrace. Antichrist arrives before Jesus does. Little is known about Habakkuk. He was a prophet to Judah. Israel was very close to be taken by the Assyrians approx. 515 BC)

- **1** The <u>burden</u> which Habakkuk the prophet did see. (burden- oracle)
- ²O LORD, how long shall I cry, and thou wilt not hear! even cry out unto thee of violence, and thou wilt not save!
- ³ Why dost thou shew me iniquity, and cause me to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence are before me: and there are that raise up strife and contention. (The people of Judah have become evil)
- ⁴Therefore the law is slacked, and judgment doth never go forth: for the <u>wicked</u> doth compass about the righteous; therefore wrong judgment proceedeth. (Corruption in the government and in the temple. Good people are surrounded by the wicked and the greedy) (Wicked = the chief prince Rosh – This was a bad translation. Some believe that it is Russia today, while others believe it is the Arabic nations today)
- ⁵Behold ye among the heathen, and regard, and wonder marvelously: for I will work a work in your days which ye will not believe, though it be told you.
- ⁶ For, lo, I raise up the <u>Chaldeans</u>, that bitter and hasty nation, which shall march through the breadth of the land, to possess the dwellingplaces that are not their's. (Chaldeans = Babylon confusion and false teachings; the king of Babylon is a type for antichrist in the end times) (Babylon will conquer Judah in about 200 years from this prophecy)
- They are terrible and dreadful: their judgment and their dignity shall proceed of themselves. (They do whatever they want to do)
- *Their horses also are swifter than the leopards, and are more fierce than the evening wolves: and their horsemen shall spread themselves, and their horsemen shall come from far; they shall fly as the eagle that hasteth to eat. (Back then, this was the Babylonians; Future Prophecy for the locust army of Revelation muslims and Kenites working for antichrist)

- They shall come all for violence: their faces shall sup up as the east wind, and they shall gather the captivity as the sand. (They capture as many people as the sands of the desert)
- ¹⁰ And they shall scoff at the kings, and the princes shall be a scorn unto them: they shall deride every strong hold; for they shall heap dust, and take it. (They built up mounds of earth against walled cities to take them. Today, this is an analogy for how deception works as well)
- ¹¹Then shall his mind change, and he shall pass over, and offend, imputing this his power unto his god. (False religious teachings, political correctness; all unto the antichrist in the future)
- ¹² Art thou not from everlasting, O LORD my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die. O LORD, thou hast ordained them for judgment; and, O mighty God, thou hast established them for correction. (God will send them to correct the evil ones in Israel and Judah)
- ¹³ Thou art of purer eyes than to behold <u>evil</u>, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, and holdest thy tongue <u>when the wicked devoureth the man that is more righteous than he?</u> (The word evil here is Chief prince Rosh Rush Russia or Arabia. A prophecy for the end times) (Through deceit, usury, manipulation)
- ¹⁴ And makest <u>men</u> as the fishes of the sea, as the creeping things, that have no ruler over them? (men= Adam; Antichrist & the Kenites prey upon God's people as if they were just animals)
- ¹⁵ They take up all of them with the angle, they catch them in their net, and gather them in their drag: therefore they rejoice and are glad. (Like catching fish in a net) (Ironically, the fish later became the cipher for Christianity)
- ¹⁶ Therefore they sacrifice unto their net, and burn incense unto their drag; because by them their portion is fat, and their meat plenteous. (They get wealthy by ripping off the honest and good Christian people in business, commerce and political correctness; and with false religious teachings in spirituality)
- ¹⁷ Shall they therefore empty their net, and not spare continually to slay the nations? (Through their one-world system, which will be headed up by antichrist in the end)
