Jeremiah 51

King James Version (KJV)

51 Thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will raise up against Babylon, and against them that dwell in the midst of them that <u>rise up against me</u>, a destroying wind; (Those that are against God are the citizens of Babylon – the deceived, agnostics, atheists, muslims)

(There is a cryptogram in verse 1 – rise up against me – in Hebrew – reverse the order of first letter of each word – and you get the word Chaldeans) (It is the deceived people that follow antichrist against the Elect and God)

- ²And will send unto Babylon <u>fanners</u>, that shall fan her, and shall empty her land: for in the day of trouble they shall be against her round about. (Fanners- winnowing fans harvesters)
- ³ Against him that bendeth let the archer bend his bow, and against him that lifteth himself up in his <u>brigandine</u>: and spare ye not her young men; destroy ye utterly all her host. (brigandine= armor)
- ⁴Thus the slain shall fall in the land of the Chaldeans, and they that are thrust through in her streets. (Chaldeans are the citizens of Babel, the deceived; they will be gravely wounded when they wake up and realize that they have worshipped antichrist)
- ⁵ For Israel hath not been forsaken, nor Judah of his God, of the LORD of hosts; though their land was filled with sin against the Holy One of Israel. (God never forget them; they forgot God)
- ⁶ Flee out of the midst of Babylon, and deliver every man his soul: be not cut off in her iniquity; for this is the time of the LORD's vengeance; he will render unto her a recompence. (By learning the truth the Word of God)
- ⁷Babylon hath been a golden cup in the LORD's hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad. Revelation-17:4 (The woman is Babylon the deceived people who worship and follow antichrist, thinking that he is Jesus, returned)
- ⁸ Babylon is suddenly fallen and destroyed: howl for her; take balm for her pain, if so be she may be healed. (She can't be healed she is the work of Satan)

- ⁹We would have healed Babylon, but she is not healed: forsake her, and let us go every one into his own country: for her judgment reacheth unto heaven, and is lifted up even to the skies. Zechariah-5
- ¹⁰ The LORD hath brought forth our righteousness: come, and let us declare in Zion the work of the LORD our God.
- ¹¹ Make bright the arrows; gather the shields: the LORD hath raised up the spirit of the kings of the Medes: for his device is against Babylon, to destroy it; because it is the vengeance of the LORD, the vengeance of his temple. (In the past, this was Cyrus. In the future it will be the Elect who witness for Jesus)
- ¹² Set up the standard upon the walls of Babylon, make the watch strong, set up the watchmen, prepare the ambushes: for the LORD hath both devised and done that which he spake against the inhabitants of Babylon. Revelation-18:8
- ¹³ O thou that dwellest upon many waters, abundant in treasures, thine end is come, and the measure of thy covetousness. (Satan's one world system is done; as are the merchants who prospered in this system)
- ¹⁴The LORD of hosts hath sworn by himself, saying, Surely I will fill thee with men, as with caterpillers; and they shall lift up a shout against thee. (God's army will swarm against Babylon)
- ¹⁵ He hath made the earth by his power, he hath established the world by his wisdom, and hath stretched out the heaven by his understanding. See Job-38 (When God told Job to stand up and think about what God has done)
- ¹⁶ When he uttereth his voice, there is a multitude of waters in the heavens; and he causeth the vapours to ascend from the ends of the earth: he maketh lightnings with rain, and bringeth forth the wind out of his treasures. (Nature is also the work of God; He commands it)
- ¹⁷ Every man is brutish by his knowledge; every founder is confounded by the graven image: for his molten image is falsehood, and there is no breath in them. (Man knows very little, yet, people believe men's doctrines instead of the Word of God)
- ¹⁸They are vanity, the work of errors: in the time of their visitation they shall perish. (Men's religions mean nothing)

- ¹⁹The portion of Jacob is not like them; for he is the former of all things: and Israel is the rod of his inheritance: the LORD of hosts is his name. (God is our inheritance)
- ²⁰ Thou art my battle axe and weapons of war: for with thee will I break in pieces the nations, and with thee will I destroy kingdoms; (Speaking about Cyrus. God chose him before he was born and named him; Future- the Elect will be God's weapon) see Mark-13
- ²¹ And with thee will I break in pieces the horse and his rider; and with thee will I break in pieces the chariot and his rider; (In the future, God will use the Elect to destroy confusion and false doctrine)
- ²² With thee also will I break in pieces man and woman; and with thee will I break in pieces old and young; and with thee will I break in pieces the young man and the maid; (All people will wake up when God speaks through the Elect; the deception of antichrist will be broken)
- ²³ I will also break in pieces with thee the shepherd and his flock; and with thee will I break in pieces the husbandman and his yoke of oxen; and with thee will I break in pieces captains and rulers. (The false shepherd is Satan; captains and rulers are false preachers and crooked politicians; the deception is over forever)
- ²⁴ And I will render unto Babylon and to all the inhabitants of Chaldea all their evil that they have done in Zion in your sight, saith the LORD. (The cup of God's wrath will be poured out on them. God does it, not the Elect. They are just His method)
- ²⁵ Behold, I am against thee, <u>O destroying mountain</u>, saith the LORD, which destroyest all the earth: and I will stretch out mine hand upon thee, and roll thee down from the rocks, and will make thee a burnt mountain. (O destroying mountain- the Kenite people with Satan and his fallen angels leading them; also the one world system that everyone will join)
- ²⁶ And they shall not take of thee a stone for a corner, nor a stone for foundations; but thou shalt be desolate for ever, saith the LORD. (They won't re-build)
- ²⁷ Set ye up a standard in the land, blow the trumpet among the nations, prepare the nations against her, call together against her the kingdoms of Ararat, Minni, and Ashchenaz; appoint a captain against

her; cause the horses to come up as the rough caterpillers. (Ararat=high holy place, Minni= division; Ashchenaz= the spreading fire) (Warn the people and expose the deception)

²⁸ Prepare against her the nations with the kings of the Medes, the captains thereof, and all the rulers thereof, and all the land of his dominion. (The Medes defeated the Babylonians after 70 years of their captivity of Israel)

Revelation-9 (God's Elect will be the army that comes up against antichrist and the one world system to destroy it. Their weapon will be the Word of God, spoken through them. God will do the speaking, not them)

- ²⁹ And the land shall tremble and sorrow: for every purpose of the LORD shall be performed against Babylon, to make the land of Babylon a desolation without an inhabitant.
- ³⁰ The mighty men of Babylon have <u>forborn</u> to fight, they have remained in their holds: their might hath failed; they became as women: they have burned her dwellingplaces; her bars are broken. (forborn= ceased) (Their courage ends when they are identified as the cause of world confusion. When Satan is thrown into the pit for 1000 years, they have nothing left to fight for)
- ³¹ One post shall run to meet another, and one messenger to meet another, to shew the king of Babylon that his city is taken at one end, (It doesn't have a chance)
- ³² And that the passages are stopped, and the reeds they have burned with fire, and the men of war are affrighted. (Who can stand against God? No one)
- ³³ For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; The daughter of Babylon is like a threshingfloor, it is time to thresh her: yet a little while, and the time of her harvest shall come. (On the threshing floor, the wheat is beaten to separate the grain from the chaff; to separate the good from the evil)
- ³⁴ Nebuchadrezzar the king of Babylon hath devoured <u>me</u>, he hath crushed <u>me</u>, he hath made <u>me</u> an empty vessel, he hath swallowed <u>me</u> up like a dragon, he hath filled his belly with my delicates, he hath cast <u>me</u> out. (me= us -> plural in the Hebrew manuscripts bad translation)

- ³⁵ The violence done to <u>me</u> and to my flesh be upon Babylon, shall the inhabitant of Zion say; and my blood upon the inhabitants of Chaldea, shall Jerusalem say. (me= us plural; bad translation) (Verses 34 and 35 are plural in the Hebrew manuscripts)
- ³⁶ Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will plead thy cause, and take vengeance for thee; and I will dry up her sea, and make her springs dry. (The Euphrates River is symbolic for the border between Israel and Babylon God's people and the deceivers <muslims and Kenites>) (Jesus <God in the flesh> is our advocate. How can we lose?)
- ³⁷ And Babylon shall become heaps, a dwellingplace for dragons, an astonishment, and an hissing, without an inhabitant. (dragons = jackals better translation)
- ³⁸They shall roar together like lions: they shall yell as lions' whelps. (They will complain and curse God to no avail)
- ³⁹ In their heat I will make their feasts, and I will make them drunken, that they may rejoice, and sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the LORD. (They will fall into a drunken stupor. They will have to wait until the end of the millennium to be tested in order to gain their immortality. Those that fail at the second resurrection will die) Revelation-20
- ⁴⁰ I will bring them down like lambs to the slaughter, like rams with he goats. (Lambs are helpless without the shepherd)
- 41 How is <u>Sheshach</u> taken! and how is the praise of the whole earth surprised! how is Babylon become an astonishment among the nations! (Sheshach if you reverse the letters in the Hebrew alphabet, Sheshach = Babyl. This word is a cryptogram in the Hebrew)
- ⁴²The sea is come up upon Babylon: she is covered with the multitude of the waves thereof. (Babylon is synonymous for confusion in prophecy)
- ⁴³ Her cities are a desolation, a dry land, and a wilderness, a land wherein no man dwelleth, neither doth any son of man pass thereby. (Confusion is gone after the millennium; God's truth has destroyed confusion forever)

- (After the millennium, those who didn't make the first resurrection will be tested. Those who still side with Satan aren't confused. It is a rebellion against God. That's why they will be destroyed at that time. They will have used all their chances. There is no redeeming these losers)
- ⁴⁴ And I will punish Bel in Babylon, and I will bring forth out of his mouth that which he hath swallowed up: and the nations shall not flow together any more unto him: yea, the wall of Babylon shall fall. (Bel was a heathen idol in Babylon) (God is the wall for Christians) see Ezekiel-38-39
- ⁴⁵ My people, go ye out of the midst of her, and deliver ye every man his soul from the fierce anger of the LORD. (Come out of Babel, come out of confusion)
- ⁴⁶ And lest your heart faint, and ye fear for the rumour that shall be heard in the land; a rumour shall both come one year, and after that in another year shall come a rumour, and violence in the land, ruler against ruler. (3 1/2 years, shortened to 5 months by Christ the season of the locust) Mark-13, Mathew-24, Luke-21
- ⁴⁷Therefore, behold, the days come, that I will do judgment upon the graven images of Babylon: and her whole land shall be confounded, and all her slain shall fall in the midst of her. (They worship the creation instead of the Creator)
- ⁴⁸ Then the heaven and the earth, and all that is therein, shall sing for Babylon: for <u>the spoilers</u> shall come unto her from the north, saith the LORD. (The spoilers are the Elect; truth spoils the deception of antichrist)
- ⁴⁹ As Babylon hath caused the slain of Israel to fall, so at Babylon shall fall the slain of all the earth. (She will receive all that she has put on Israel)
- ⁵⁰ Ye that have escaped the sword, go away, stand not still: remember the LORD afar off, and let Jerusalem come into your mind. (Watch Jerusalem for a barometer of the times)
- ⁵¹ We are confounded, because we have heard reproach: shame hath covered our faces: for <u>strangers</u> are come into the sanctuaries of the LORD's house. (Strangers- the antichrist, his fallen angels and the Kenites that follow them)

- ⁵² Wherefore, behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will do judgment upon her graven images: and through all her land the wounded shall groan.
- ⁵³ Though Babylon should mount up to heaven, and though she should fortify the height of her strength, yet from me shall <u>spoilers</u> come unto her, saith the LORD. (Spoilers = impregnable <Hebrew>, they are unstoppable; all her strength, power and money won't stop the Lord from abasing her; God's spoilers are His Elect)
- ⁵⁴ A sound of a cry cometh from Babylon, and great destruction from the land of the Chaldeans: (Confusion is destroyed)
- ⁵⁵ Because the LORD hath spoiled Babylon, and destroyed out of her the great voice; when her waves do roar like great waters, a noise of their voice is uttered:
- ⁵⁶ Because the spoiler is come upon her, even upon Babylon, and her mighty men are taken, every one of their bows is broken: for the LORD God of recompences shall surely requite. Ezekiel-39 (God destroys the locust army at Armageddon and Haman-Gog)
- ⁵⁷ And I will make <u>drunk</u> her princes, and her wise men, her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name is the LORD of hosts. (Drunk like in a stupor, they stumble, make bad choices and lose all common sense)
- ⁵⁸ Thus saith the LORD of hosts; The <u>broad walls</u> of Babylon shall be utterly broken, and her high gates shall be burned with fire; and the people shall labour in vain, and the folk in the fire, and they shall be weary. (Broad walls double walls much more defensible; they won't stand before God and His Spoilers)
- 59 The word which Jeremiah the prophet commanded Seraiah the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, when he went with Zedekiah the king of Judah into Babylon in the fourth year of his reign. And this Seraiah was a quiet prince. (Seraiah- was Baruch's brother. Seraiah means-Yah has prevailed)
- [™] So Jeremiah wrote in a book all the evil that should come upon Babylon, even all these words that are written against Babylon. (God, through Jeremiah and Baruch is sending His Prophecies against Babylon, to Babylon. Daniel, the other prices, and the people of Judah

were already there. They were taken into captivity years before. Nebuchadnezzar would no doubt hear these prophecies as well)

- 61 And Jeremiah said to Seraiah, When thou comest to Babylon, and shalt see, and shalt read all these words; (Deliver the Word of God <Book of Jeremiah> to the faithful people from Judah who are living in captivity in Babylon. God told them to go into captivity in Babylon and they obeyed and did just fine. Those who disobeyed died in Jerusalem)
- ⁶² Then shalt thou say, O LORD, thou hast spoken against this place, to cut it off, that none shall remain in it, neither man nor beast, but that it shall be desolate for ever. (In the end times, confusion <Babel> will be destroyed forever by the truth of God's Word)
- ⁶³ And it shall be, when thou hast made an end of reading this book, that thou shalt bind a stone to it, and cast it into the midst of Euphrates: (The Euphrates is a symbol for the separation between Israel and Babylon <the heathen>. Today: it is a separation between the Christian nations and islam <the heathen>)
- ⁶⁴ And thou shalt say, Thus shall Babylon sink, and shall not rise from the evil that I will bring upon her: and they shall be weary. Thus far are the words of Jeremiah.
