

Revelation 14

King James Version (KJV)

(Chapter 14 was written to people on Earth. Chapter 15 was written about Heaven)

14 And I looked, and, lo, a Lamb stood on the mount Sion, and with him an hundred forty and four thousand, having his Father's name written in their foreheads. (The Lamb is Christ, standing on Mount Zion, at His return. The 144,000 are the believers that wake up from their stupor because of the testimony of the Elect before antichrist)

Hebrews-12:22-29 (Paul wrote about this time) (Jesus is here. All people have died in the blink of an eye. We are all there in our spiritual bodies. We now have total recall of all that happened in the First Age. The Second Age is now finished. The fallen angels have died and the Millennium has begun)

²And I heard a voice from heaven, as the voice of many waters, and as the voice of a great thunder: and I heard the voice of harpers harping with their harps: (This is God's voice. It completely frightened the Israelites when Moses led them out of Egypt) Exodus-20:18-21

³And they sung as it were a new song before the throne, and before the four beasts, and the elders: and no man could learn that song but the hundred and forty and four thousand, which were redeemed from the earth. Revelation-2:17 (The new song) (The 144,000 are those that woke up during the tribulation of antichrist, and returned to God. The testimony of the Elect woke them when the Holy Spirit spoke through the Elect)

⁴These are they which were not defiled with women; for they are virgins. These are they which follow the Lamb whithersoever he goeth. These were redeemed from among men, being the firstfruits unto God and to the Lamb. (Spiritual virgins, not seduced by antichrist and his angels; God sees idolatry the way we see adultery)

⁵And in their mouth was found no guile: for they are without fault before the throne of God. (Stay in God's Word and stay away from the doctrines of men; and you won't be ashamed to stand before God's throne)

⁶And I saw another angel fly in the midst of heaven, having the everlasting gospel to preach unto them that dwell on the earth, and to every nation, and kindred, and tongue, and people, **Deuteronomy-15**

⁷Saying with a loud voice, **fear God**, and give glory to him; for the hour of his judgment is come: and worship him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters. (**Fear God= revere God – better translation**)

⁸And there followed another angel, saying, Babylon is fallen, is fallen, that great city, because she made all nations drink of the wine of the wrath of her fornication. (**The deception of antichrist is over, because the true Christ is returned**)

⁹And the third angel followed them, saying with a loud voice, If any man worship the beast and his image, and receive his mark in his forehead, or in his hand,

¹⁰The same shall drink of the wine of the wrath of God, which is poured out without mixture into the cup of his indignation; and he shall be tormented with fire and brimstone in the presence of the holy angels, and in the presence of the Lamb: (**They are humiliated for having been deceived by antichrist. This is the second tribulation. The tribulation of God, upon the foolish**)

Mathew-26:39 (this is the cup of the wrath of God that Jesus had asked if it could pass, just before His crucifixion. When the Kenites murdered Jesus, they sealed their fate)

¹¹And the smoke of their torment ascendeth up for ever and ever: and they have no rest day nor night, who worship the beast and his image, and whosoever receiveth the mark of his name. (**Their torment is their shame; and then the death of their souls, at judgment; if they don't repent and are forgiven**)

¹²Here is the patience of the saints: here are they that keep the commandments of God, and the faith of Jesus. (**Those who waited patiently through the tribulation of Satan, for the return of Christ**)

See Psalms-37 (Why does it seem like the evil always get ahead of the good? They don't. Their day of reckoning is coming; and the good will witness their chastisement)

¹³ And I heard a voice from heaven saying unto me, Write, Blessed are the dead which die in the Lord from henceforth: Yea, saith the Spirit, that they may rest from their labours; and their works do follow them. (Our good labors and our good works are the rewards that follow us into Paradise. Our faith gets us in, but our works are our rewards) see Revelation-19:8

¹⁴ And I looked, and behold a white cloud, and upon the cloud one sat like unto the Son of man, having on his head a golden crown, and in his hand a sharp sickle. (Harvest time)

¹⁵ And another angel came out of the temple, crying with a loud voice to him that sat on the cloud, Thrust in thy sickle, and reap: for the time is come for thee to reap; for the harvest of the earth is ripe. (Judgment day)

¹⁶ And he that sat on the cloud thrust in his sickle on the earth; and the earth was reaped. (This is the end of all flesh on the Earth)

¹⁷ And another angel came out of the temple which is in heaven, he also having a sharp sickle. (A sickle is for harvesting wheat)

¹⁸ And another angel came out from the altar, which had power over fire; and cried with a loud cry to him that had the sharp sickle, saying, Thrust in thy sharp sickle, and gather the clusters of the vine of the earth; for her grapes are fully ripe. (Grapes are not harvested with a sickle. This harvest is for the evil ones and for the Kenites. A sickle destroys the grapes. The vine is the family tree of the Kenites all the way back to Cain, and his father, Satan)

¹⁹ And the angel thrust in his sickle into the earth, and gathered the vine of the earth, and cast it into the great winepress of the wrath of God. (This is the wrath of God upon the evil, and those who follow Satan – the Kenites. This is the cup that Jesus asked if it could pass from Him, right before He was crucified)

(God is avenging all the good people who suffered at the hands of the Kenites and their evil accomplices throughout the Second Age. This is the justice that their victims have been asking for)

²⁰ And the winepress was trodden without the city, and blood came out of the winepress, even unto the horse bridles, by the space of a thousand and six hundred furlongs. (A little less than 200 miles – probably at Megiddo – the gathering place of the evil ones in

Jerusalem) (The atheists are going to learn real fast that there is a God in Heaven and He knows what they have been doing)
