

Psalm 114

King James Version (KJV)

114 When Israel went out of Egypt, the house of Jacob from a people of strange language; **Exodus-13:3**

²Judah was his sanctuary, and Israel his dominion. **(was- became)**

³The sea saw it, and fled: Jordan was driven back. **(God moved both these waters for Israel – the Red Sea at the beginning, and the Jordan at the end of Israel's exodus)**

⁴The mountains skipped like rams, and the little hills like lambs. **Exodus-19:18**

⁵What ailed thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, that thou wast driven back?

⁶Ye mountains, that ye skipped like rams; and ye little hills, like lambs?

⁷Tremble, thou earth, at the presence of the Lord, at the presence of the God of Jacob;

⁸Which turned the rock into a standing water, the flint into a fountain of waters. **(The stone of Destiny – Jacob's pillar. God, through Moses, gave them water in the desert for 40 years)**
