## Jeremiah 28

King James Version (KJV)

- **28** And it came to pass the same year, in the beginning of the reign of Zedekiah king of Judah, in the fourth year, and in the fifth month, that <u>Hananiah</u> the son of Azur the prophet, which was of Gibeon, spake unto me in the house of the LORD, in the presence of the priests and of all the people, saying, (Hananiah gift of Yah)
- <sup>2</sup>Thus speaketh the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saying, I have broken the yoke of the king of Babylon. (He is a false prophet. God never said that. HE said that they should go into Babylon for 70 years)
- <sup>3</sup> Within two full years will I bring again into this place all the vessels of the LORD's house, that Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took away from this place, and carried them to Babylon: (He is telling them whatever they want to hear. God said that they won't be back for 70 years)
- <sup>4</sup>And I will bring again to this place <u>Jeconiah</u> the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah, with all the captives of Judah, that went into Babylon, saith the LORD: for I will break the yoke of the king of Babylon. (God took His name out of the name Jeconiah and called him Coniah because of his evil deeds. Yet Hananiah <a false prophet> is putting God's name back into that deposed, corrupt and evil ex-king. This shows that he has no idea of what God wants from them. God never sent him)
- <sup>5</sup>Then the prophet Jeremiah said unto the prophet Hananiah in the presence of the priests, and in the presence of all the people that stood in the house of the LORD,
- <sup>6</sup> Even the prophet Jeremiah said, Amen: the LORD do so: the LORD perform thy words which thou hast prophesied, to bring again the vessels of the LORD's house, and all that is carried away captive, from Babylon into this place. (Jeremiah is mocking him)
- Nevertheless hear thou now this word that I speak in thine ears, and in the ears of all the people; (Now hear the truth from God)
- The prophets that have been before me and before thee of old prophesied both against many countries, and against great kingdoms, of war, and of evil, and of pestilence.

- The prophet which prophesieth of peace, when the word of the prophet shall come to pass, then shall the prophet be known, that the LORD hath truly sent him. (If your prophecy comes true, you will be proven a prophet)
- <sup>10</sup> Then Hananiah the prophet took the yoke from off the prophet Jeremiah's neck, and brake it. (Taking action against God and His prophet is not a good idea)
- <sup>11</sup> And Hananiah spake in the presence of all the people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Even so will I break the yoke of Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon from the neck of all nations within the space of two full years. And the prophet Jeremiah went his way. (He was putting on a good show; none of it will happen of course)
- <sup>12</sup>Then the word of the LORD came unto Jeremiah the prophet, after that Hananiah the prophet had broken the yoke from off the neck of the prophet Jeremiah, saying,
- <sup>13</sup> Go and tell Hananiah, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Thou hast broken the yokes of wood; but thou shalt make for them yokes of iron.
- <sup>14</sup> For thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; I have put a yoke of iron upon the neck of all these nations, that they may serve Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon; and they shall serve him: and I have given him the beasts of the field also. (God's plan will happen. No one will stop it)
- (Future the antichrist will come at the 6<sup>th</sup> trump, and no one will be raptured out. We will be called up to witness against him, before the whole world. The Holy Spirit will speak through us; and many people will wake up, out of their stupor)
- <sup>15</sup>Then said the prophet Jeremiah unto Hananiah the prophet, Hear now, Hananiah; The LORD hath not sent thee; but thou makest this people to trust in a lie.
- <sup>16</sup> Therefore thus saith the LORD; Behold, I will cast thee from off the face of the earth: this year thou shalt die, because thou hast taught rebellion against the LORD. (Judgment on Hananiah)
- <sup>17</sup>So Hananiah the prophet died the same year in the seventh month. (This chapter started in the 5th month. Hananiah was dead 2 months later, because he for defied God)
