

## Jeremiah 46

King James Version (KJV)

**46** The word of the LORD which came to Jeremiah the prophet against the Gentiles; (God's message to the heathen nations – history & prophecy)

<sup>2</sup>Against Egypt, against the army of Pharaohnecho king of Egypt, which was by the river Euphrates in Carchemish, which Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon smote in the fourth year of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah. (necho = lame; he must have been lame)

<sup>3</sup>Order ye the buckler and shield, and draw near to battle.

<sup>4</sup>Harness the horses; and get up, ye horsemen, and stand forth with your helmets; furbish the spears, and put on the brigandines. (brigandines - a coat of mail)

<sup>5</sup>Wherefore have I seen them dismayed and turned away back? and their mighty ones are beaten down, and are fled apace, and look not back: for fear was round about, saith the LORD.

<sup>6</sup>Let not the swift flee away, nor the mighty man escape; they shall stumble, and fall toward the north by the river Euphrates. (Euphrates is the border between our people Israel, and Babylon – the muslims of today)

<sup>7</sup>Who is this that cometh up as a flood, whose waters are moved as the rivers?

<sup>8</sup>Egypt riseth up like a flood, and his waters are moved like the rivers; and he saith, I will go up, and will cover the earth; I will destroy the city and the inhabitants thereof. (The Arab spring of today; Muslims are responsible for most wars going on today)

<sup>9</sup>Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield; and the Lydians, that handle and bend the bow. (Lydians= Libya of today)

<sup>10</sup>For this is the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the

Lord GOD of hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates. (Muslims have been killing millions since they were founded by Mohammad. Their so called religion is hell-bent on destroying Christians. The Day of Vengeance will come upon them at the end of this age) (The sword of the Lord is His Word)

<sup>11</sup> Go up into Gilead, and take balm, O virgin, the daughter of Egypt: in vain shalt thou use many medicines; for thou shalt not be cured. See Daniel-11

<sup>12</sup> The nations have heard of thy shame, and thy cry hath filled the land: for the mighty man hath stumbled against the mighty, and they are fallen both together. (Their shame is Islam; a false religion of murder, rape and conquest. Allah is not God; Yahoveh is God)

<sup>13</sup> The word that the LORD spake to Jeremiah the prophet, how Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon should come and smite the land of Egypt. (See Josephus Antiquities book 10 for a second point of view)

<sup>14</sup> Declare ye in Egypt, and publish in Migdol, and publish in Noph and in Tahpanhes: say ye, Stand fast, and prepare thee; for the sword shall devour round about thee. (This is why God didn't want the remnant of Judah to go to Egypt. He wanted that remnant to stay in Judah, and serve the king of Babylon, temporarily, until all Judah could return <70 years later>. They refused to listen, and went to Egypt, only to die with the Egyptians)

<sup>15</sup> Why are thy valiant men swept away? they stood not, because the LORD did drive them. (They fled when God told them to stand fast)

<sup>16</sup> He made many to fall, yea, one fell upon another: and they said, Arise, and let us go again to our own people, and to the land of our nativity, from the oppressing sword. (It's too late for them. God told them not to go to Egypt)

<sup>17</sup> They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt is but a noise; he hath passed the time appointed. (How difficult is it to defeat a noise; he will fall to the Chaldeans)

<sup>18</sup> As I live, saith the King, whose name is the LORD of hosts, Surely as Tabor is among the mountains, and as Carmel by the sea, so shall he come. (Tabor = a small mound; Carmel = a pleasant place)

<sup>19</sup> O thou daughter dwelling in Egypt, furnish thyself to go into captivity: for Noph shall be waste and desolate without an inhabitant.

<sup>20</sup> Egypt is like a very fair heifer, but destruction cometh; it cometh out of the north. (A heifer is a gentle animal, easy to tame, easy to control; they went to Egypt expecting to find a warhorse, but only found a heifer that can't protect them against Babylon)

<sup>21</sup> Also her hired men are in the midst of her like fatted bullocks; for they also are turned back, and are fled away together: they did not stand, because the day of their calamity was come upon them, and the time of their visitation. (Her hired men = mercenaries; a paid army with no loyalties)

<sup>22</sup> The voice thereof shall go like a serpent; for they shall march with an army, and come against her with axes, as hewers of wood. (The word serpent here is the same serpent in the Garden and the same serpent that will return as antichrist – Satan)

<sup>23</sup> They shall cut down her forest, saith the LORD, though it cannot be searched; because they are more than the grasshoppers, and are innumerable. (Then, it was the Babylonians; today it is the muslims – swarms, destroyers, killers)

<sup>24</sup> The daughter of Egypt shall be confounded; she shall be delivered into the hand of the people of the north. (Babylon then; antichrist in the future)

<sup>25</sup> The LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, saith; Behold, I will punish the multitude of No, and Pharaoh, and Egypt, with their gods, and their kings; even Pharaoh, and all them that trust in him: (Today, hundreds of Christian churches are being burned down all over the muslim world, and millions of Christians are being murdered)

<sup>26</sup> And I will deliver them into the hand of those that seek their lives, and into the hand of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, and into the hand of his servants: and afterward it shall be inhabited, as in the days of old, saith the LORD.

<sup>27</sup> But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make him afraid. (In the last days and on the

Lord's Day – those that love Yahoveh, not Allah, will be protected by Yahoveh)

<sup>28</sup> Fear thou not, O Jacob my servant, saith the LORD: for I am with thee; for I will make a full end of all the nations whither I have driven thee: but I will not make a full end of thee, but correct thee in measure; yet will I not leave thee wholly unpunished. (We all get what we deserve – God is fair to everyone; we are not without sin either)

(Egypt is one of the oldest nations on earth. It has been a base nation since God judged it, in the days of Moses. It will continue to be a base nation until the end of this age)
