

Psalm 45

For the sons of Ko-rah, Mas-chil, A song of loves
King James Version (KJV) (Mas-chil= instruction or understanding)

45 My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things which I have made touching the king: my tongue is the pen of a ready writer. (inditing= bubbling over with joy)

²Thou art fairer than the children of men: grace is poured into thy lips: therefore God hath blessed thee for ever. (Prophetic of Jesus' great wedding on the Lord's day)

³Gird thy sword upon thy thigh, O most mighty, with thy glory and thy majesty. Rev-1:16

⁴And in thy majesty ride prosperously because of truth and meekness and righteousness; and thy right hand shall teach thee terrible things. (terrible= awesome) (ride - Rev-6:2 the fake, Rev-19 the true Christ)

⁵Thine arrows are sharp in the heart of the king's enemies; whereby the people fall under thee. (Armageddon & Haman-Gog)

⁶Thy throne, O God, is for ever and ever: the sceptre of thy kingdom is a right sceptre. (right= just) (After Armageddon, Christ rules)

⁷Thou lovest righteousness, and hatest wickedness: therefore God, thy God, hath anointed thee with the oil of gladness above thy fellows.

⁸All thy garments smell of myrrh, and aloes, and cassia, out of the ivory palaces, whereby they have made thee glad.

⁹Kings' daughters were among thy honourable women: upon thy right hand did stand the queen in gold of Ophir. (In those days, Ophir produced the purest gold)

¹⁰Hearken, O daughter, and consider, and incline thine ear; forget also thine own people, and thy father's house;

¹¹So shall the king greatly desire thy beauty: for he is thy Lord; and worship thou him.

¹²And the daughter of Tyre shall be there with a gift; even the rich among the people shall intreat thy favour. (Tyre refers to Kenites)

¹³ The king's daughter is all glorious within: her clothing is of wrought gold. (The bride of Christ sits in the inner court of the temple)

¹⁴ She shall be brought unto the king in raiment of needlework: the virgins her companions that follow her shall be brought unto thee. (Rev-19... Our robes are made of our righteous works)

¹⁵ With gladness and rejoicing shall they be brought: they shall enter into the king's palace.

¹⁶ Instead of thy fathers shall be thy children, whom thou mayest make princes in all the earth. (The elect- the Zadok)

¹⁷ I will make thy name to be remembered in all generations: therefore shall the people praise thee for ever and ever.
