

## Jeremiah 27

King James Version (KJV)

**27** In the beginning of the reign of Jehoiakim the son of Josiah king of Judah came this word unto Jeremiah from the LORD, saying,  
(Jehoiakim- this should be Zedekiah- This was a copyists error in translating the manuscripts. See verse 3 this chapter)

<sup>2</sup> Thus saith the LORD to me; Make thee bonds and yokes, and put them upon thy neck, (The yoke was used on animals to help them to pull heavy burdens. It protected the neck from chafing from the leather harness. They're going into captivity. The nation is done. If the people choose to follow God, then they will be well treated, even in captivity)

<sup>3</sup> And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah; (All these kingdoms will be taken by the Chaldeans)

<sup>4</sup> And command them to say unto their masters, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel; Thus shall ye say unto your masters;

<sup>5</sup> I have made the earth, the man and the beast that are upon the ground, by my great power and by my outstretched arm, and have given it unto whom it seemed meet unto me.

<sup>6</sup> And now have I given all these lands into the hand of Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, my servant; and the beasts of the field have I given him also to serve him. (God is using Nebuchadnezzar to straighten out these people, and chastise them for their evil deeds. The enemy who will conquer them is actually serving God)

(God uses whoever he wants to in order to fulfill His plan. In the end days, antichrist <Satan> who deceives the whole world, will also be serving God, whether he knows it or not. God will use him to test the people. Who will follow antichrist and his one world system at the 6<sup>th</sup> Trump; and who will remain faithful to God and wait for the return of Jesus at the 7<sup>th</sup> Trump)

<sup>7</sup> And all nations shall serve him, and his son, and his son's son, until the very time of his land come: and then many nations and great kings shall serve themselves of him. (This will be Darius of the

Persians and the Medes. His successor, Cyrus will allow the Jews to return to Jerusalem after 70 years of captivity to Babylon)

<sup>8</sup>And it shall come to pass, that the nation and kingdom which will not serve the same Nebuchadnezzar the king of Babylon, and that will not put their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, that nation will I punish, saith the LORD, with the sword, and with the famine, and with the pestilence, until I have consumed them by his hand. (God wants them to submit to Nebuchadnezzar and go into captivity. Zedekiah will refuse and will be killed for it. Those who agree will live under Babylon for 70 years in peace) (Those who fight against God's plan will always lose)

<sup>9</sup>Therefore hearken not ye to your prophets, nor to your diviners, nor to your dreamers, nor to your enchanters, nor to your sorcerers, which speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon: (They are all fake religious people, wizards and con men)

<sup>10</sup>For they prophesy a lie unto you, to remove you far from your land; and that I should drive you out, and ye should perish. Mark-13:9-12 (Don't be deceived by fake Christian preachers) Jeremiah-17:5 (Cursed be the man who puts his trust in men, instead of God)

<sup>11</sup>But the nations that bring their neck under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him, those will I let remain still in their own land, saith the LORD; and they shall till it, and dwell therein.

(Israel and all the surrounding nations worshipped idols and practiced human sacrifice of their own children to Molech. God used Babylon to conquer these nations and end the human sacrifice and many other perversions which they had refused to end on their own)

<sup>12</sup>I spake also to Zedekiah king of Judah according to all these words, saying, Bring your necks under the yoke of the king of Babylon, and serve him and his people, and live. (Zedekiah agreed, and then changed his mind and resisted. He broke his oath to God and to Babylon. It cost him his life)

<sup>13</sup>Why will ye die, thou and thy people, by the sword, by the famine, and by the pestilence, as the LORD hath spoken against the nation that will not serve the king of Babylon? (This is God's plan. Why do you resist? Cooperate and prosper; resist and die)

<sup>14</sup> Therefore hearken not unto the words of the prophets that speak unto you, saying, Ye shall not serve the king of Babylon: for they prophesy a lie unto you.

<sup>15</sup> For I have not sent them, saith the LORD, yet they prophesy a lie in my name; that I might drive you out, and that ye might perish, ye, and the prophets that prophesy unto you. (The same happens today with rapture preachers and Easter celebrators)

<sup>16</sup> Also I spake to the priests and to all this people, saying, Thus saith the LORD; Hearken not to the words of your prophets that prophesy unto you, saying, Behold, the vessels of the LORD's house shall now shortly be brought again from Babylon: for they prophesy a lie unto you. (In an earlier siege, Babylon had already taken the gold and silver out of Judah)

<sup>17</sup> Hearken not unto them; serve the king of Babylon, and live: wherefore should this city be laid waste?

Revelation-9 (Satan comes at the 6<sup>th</sup> trump. He will rule for 5 months. We are to witness against him. There is no rapture. We are needed here to publish God's Word around the world, when antichrist calls us up to intimidate us. God's Holy Spirit will speak through us in a language that all people will understand, as it happened in Acts)

<sup>18</sup> But if they be prophets, and if the word of the LORD be with them, let them now make intercession to the LORD of hosts, that the vessels which are left in the house of the LORD, and in the house of the king of Judah, and at Jerusalem, go not to Babylon. (All they had left by this time were some brass objects. The temple had already been stripped bare by Babylon)

<sup>19</sup> For thus saith the LORD of hosts concerning the pillars, and concerning the sea, and concerning the bases, and concerning the residue of the vessels that remain in this city. 2Kings-25:13

<sup>20</sup> Which Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon took not, when he carried away captive Jeconiah the son of Jehoiakim king of Judah from Jerusalem to Babylon, and all the nobles of Judah and Jerusalem; (Daniel and his companions were taken to Babylon after one of these attacks)

<sup>21</sup>Yea, thus saith the LORD of hosts, the God of Israel, concerning the vessels that remain in the house of the LORD, and in the house of the king of Judah and of Jerusalem;

<sup>22</sup>They shall be carried to Babylon, and there shall they be until the day that I visit them, saith the LORD; then will I bring them up, and restore them to this place. 2Kings-25:13 (The brass was taken off of the temple and took it to Babylon. They took what was left of the temple)

(70 years later, The Medes and Persians will defeat Babylon and allow the Jews to return to Jerusalem. The remainder of the 10 northern tribes would eventually migrate over the Caucasus Mountains and settle Europe. They would become known as Caucasian)

(Today, most Caucasians call themselves Gentiles. They have lost their heritage down through the years due to false teaching and ignorance)
