

## Psalm 103

## A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

**103** Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, bless his holy name.

<sup>2</sup> Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits:

<sup>3</sup> Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

<sup>4</sup> Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; **Ezekiel-18:4 ->(God is our kinsman redeemer)**

<sup>5</sup> Who satisfieth thy mouth with good things; so that thy youth is renewed like the eagle's. **(Like the eagles new feathers after it molts)**

<sup>6</sup> The LORD executeth righteousness and judgment for all that are oppressed.

<sup>7</sup> He made known his ways unto Moses, his acts unto the children of Israel. **(Through miracles and the prophets)**

<sup>8</sup> The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. **2Peter-3:9**

<sup>9</sup> He will not always chide: neither will he keep his anger for ever.

<sup>10</sup> He hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. **(We usually get less punishment than we deserve, but we get more rewards than we deserve)**

<sup>11</sup> For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is his mercy toward them that fear him. **(fear- revere)**

<sup>12</sup> As far as the east is from the west, so far hath he removed our transgressions from us. **(After repentance)**

<sup>13</sup> Like as a father pitieth his children, so the LORD pitieth them that fear him. **(pitieth – has compassion for) (fear- revere)**

<sup>14</sup> For he knoweth our frame; he remembereth that we are dust. **Mark-14:38 (He knows the flesh is weak)**

<sup>15</sup> As for man, his days are as grass: as a flower of the field, so he flourisheth. [1Peter-1:24-25](#)

<sup>16</sup> For the wind passeth over it, and it is gone; and the place thereof shall know it no more. (We do NOT resurrect into the flesh, but rather in the spiritual body) [James-4:14](#)

<sup>17</sup> But the mercy of the LORD is from everlasting to everlasting upon them that fear him, and his righteousness unto children's children; (fear- revere)

<sup>18</sup> To such as keep his covenant, and to those that remember his commandments to do them. [James-1:22](#)

<sup>19</sup> The LORD hath prepared his throne in the heavens; and his kingdom ruleth over all.

<sup>20</sup> Bless the LORD, ye his angels, that excel in strength, that do his commandments, hearkening unto the voice of his word.

<sup>21</sup> Bless ye the LORD, all ye his hosts; ye ministers of his, that do his pleasure.

<sup>22</sup> Bless the LORD, all his works in all places of his dominion: bless the LORD, O my soul.
