

## **Psalm 47**

A Psalm for the sons of Ko-rah

King James Version (KJV)

**47** O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph.

<sup>2</sup>For the LORD most high is terrible; he is a great King over all the earth. (**terrible= awesome, revered**)

<sup>3</sup>He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. **Luke-20:42-43**

<sup>4</sup>He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah. **Ezekiel 44:26-27, Malachi-1:2-3**

<sup>5</sup>God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. (**gone up = exalted**) **The 7<sup>th</sup> trump -> 1Corinthians-15:52-55**

<sup>6</sup>Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises.

<sup>7</sup>For God is the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding. (**Alternate X-lation - everyone that hath understanding**)

<sup>8</sup>God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness.

<sup>9</sup>The princes of the people are gathered together, even the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth belong unto God: he is greatly exalted.
