## 2 Samuel 22

King James Version (KJV)

(The song of David – repeated in Psalms-18)

- **22** And David spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day that the LORD had delivered him out of the hand of all his enemies, and out of the hand of Saul: (A song of thanks to God)
- <sup>2</sup>And he said, The LORD is my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; (Remember this verse when it will seem like antichrist is winning, in the end days. God will be victorious)
- <sup>3</sup>The God of my rock; in him will I trust: he is my shield, and the horn of my salvation, my high tower, and my refuge, my saviour; thou savest me from violence. (When the Elect will be brought up before antichrist, the whole world will hate them for it)
- <sup>4</sup>I will call on the LORD, who is worthy to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.
- <sup>5</sup> When the waves of death compassed me, the <u>floods of ungodly men</u> made me afraid; Revelation-12:15 (The flood of lies from antichrist)
- <sup>6</sup>The <u>sorrows</u> of hell compassed me about; the snares of <u>death</u> prevented me; Hebrews-2:14 (Satan's name is death) (sorrows = chords bad translation)
- <sup>7</sup>In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry did enter into his ears. (God always hears our prayers)
- Then the earth shook and trembled; the foundations of heaven moved and shook, because he was wroth. (This is written all in Jeremiah-4 when God ended the first age) Also Hebrews-12:26 (When God will shake heaven and Earth once more in the end days)
- <sup>9</sup>There went up a smoke out of his nostrils, and fire out of his mouth devoured: coals were kindled by it. Hebrews-12:29 (Our God is a consuming fire)
- <sup>10</sup> He bowed the heavens also, and came down; and <u>darkness was</u> <u>under his feet</u>. (Satan is darkness in a spiritual way) (Light destroys darkness)

- <sup>11</sup> And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind. See Ezekiel-1
- <sup>12</sup> And he made darkness pavilions round about him, dark waters, and thick clouds of the skies. Romans-11 (God puts blinders on some people for their own protection)
- <sup>13</sup> Through the brightness before him were coals of fire kindled.
- <sup>14</sup> The LORD thundered from heaven, and the most High uttered his voice. Revelation-1:16 (Jesus' tongue is like a 2 edged sword. It cuts both ways)
- <sup>15</sup> And he sent out arrows, and scattered them; lightning, and discomfited them. (Those who oppose God are in for a bad time)
- <sup>16</sup> And the channels of the sea appeared, the foundations of the world were discovered, at the rebuking of the LORD, at the blast of the breath of his nostrils. (The birth of this Age, and the end of the First Age)
- <sup>17</sup> He sent from above, he took me; he drew me out of many waters; Revelation-17:15 (Waters are symbolic for the people. God chose David to set things right in Israel) (Moses was also drawn from the water to serve God)
- <sup>18</sup> He delivered me from my strong enemy, and from them that hated me: for they were too strong for me. (But not too strong for God) (Goliath was a good example of this verse)
- 19 They <u>prevented me</u> in the day of my calamity: but the LORD was my <u>stay</u>. (prevented me they hurried to oppose and stop me; stay= support)
- <sup>20</sup> He brought me forth also into a large place: he delivered me, because he delighted in me. (That is because David loved and served God. David remained faithful to God his whole life)
- <sup>21</sup> The LORD rewarded me according to my righteousness: according to the cleanness of my hands hath he recompensed me. (David tried very hard to live a good life in God's Laws. God rewarded David for his good works)

- <sup>22</sup> For I have kept the ways of the LORD, and have not wickedly departed from my God. (David never abandoned God by turning to idolatry)
- <sup>23</sup> For all his judgments were before me: and as for his statutes, I did not depart from them.
- <sup>24</sup>I was also upright before him, and have kept myself from mine iniquity. (No one is perfect. David did the best that he could do)
- <sup>25</sup> Therefore the LORD hath recompensed me according to my righteousness; according to my cleanness in his eye sight. (God sees all and treats everyone fairly)
- <sup>26</sup> With the merciful thou wilt shew thyself merciful, and with the upright man thou wilt shew thyself upright. (How God treats you depends on you and how you treat others)
- <sup>27</sup> With the pure thou wilt shew thyself pure; and with the froward thou wilt <u>shew</u> thyself unsavoury. (shew = wrestle better translation)
- <sup>28</sup> And the afflicted people thou wilt save: but thine eyes are upon the haughty, that thou mayest bring them down. (If you exalt yourself, God will abase you; if you humble yourself, God will exalt you)
- <sup>29</sup> For thou art my lamp, O LORD: and the LORD will lighten my darkness. (Jesus is the Light of the world) John-8:12

(With God's help, David defeated the enemy - verses 30 -> 51)

- <sup>30</sup> For by thee I have run through a troop: by my God have I leaped over a wall.
- <sup>31</sup> As for God, his way is perfect; the word of the LORD is tried: he is a buckler to all them that trust in him. (buckler = shield)
- <sup>32</sup> For who is God, save the LORD? and who is a rock, save our God? Deuteronomy-32:31 (Jesus is our rock. The Kenites' rock is not our Rock. Their rock is Satan)
- <sup>33</sup> God is my strength and power: and he maketh my way perfect. (God's way is perfect. To walk in His way is to attain perfection)

- <sup>34</sup> He maketh my feet like <u>hinds'</u> feet: and setteth me upon my high places. (hind = deer)
- <sup>35</sup> He teacheth my hands to war; so that a bow of steel is broken by mine arms. Psalms-144 (We are in a spiritual war)
- <sup>36</sup> Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy gentleness hath made me great. Ephesians-6:16 (The Gospel armor)
- <sup>37</sup>Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip. Ephesians-6:15
- <sup>38</sup> I have pursued mine enemies, and destroyed them; and turned not again until I had consumed them. (God gives us the victory)
- <sup>39</sup> And I have consumed them, and wounded them, that they could not arise: yea, they are fallen under my feet. (The Elect will put God's enemies under His feet, in the end days)
- <sup>40</sup> For thou hast <u>girded me with strength to battle</u>: them that rose up against me hast thou subdued under me. Ephesians-6:14
- <sup>41</sup> Thou hast also given me the <u>necks</u> of mine enemies, that I might destroy them that hate me. (necks = backs bad translation; the enemy runs away from you when you are on God's side)
- <sup>42</sup> They looked, but there was none to save; even unto the LORD, but he answered them not. (Those who side with antichrist will not be answered to by God)
- <sup>43</sup> Then did I beat them as small as the dust of the earth, I did stamp them as the mire of the street, and did spread them abroad. Mathew-21:44
- <sup>44</sup> Thou also hast delivered me from the strivings of my people, thou hast kept me to be head of the heathen: a people which I knew not shall serve me. (God saved David from his enemies within and without)
- <sup>45</sup> Strangers shall submit themselves unto me: as soon as they hear, they shall be obedient unto me. (On the first day of the Millennium, all souls will serve the Lord)

- <sup>46</sup> Strangers shall fade away, and they shall be afraid out of their close places. (Those who opposed God will tremble before Him)
- <sup>47</sup> The LORD liveth; and blessed be my rock; and exalted be the God of the rock of my salvation.
- <sup>48</sup> <u>It is God that avengeth me</u>, and that bringeth down the people under me. (God does all this; not David) Romans-12:19
- <sup>49</sup> And that bringeth me forth from mine enemies: thou also hast lifted me up on high above them that rose up against me: thou hast delivered me from the violent man.
- <sup>50</sup> Therefore I will give thanks unto thee, O LORD, among the heathen, and I will sing praises unto thy name. (Always thank God for His blessings and for His mercy) Romans-15:9
- <sup>51</sup> He is the tower of salvation for his king: and sheweth mercy to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.
