A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

110 The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. (The LORD- Yahoveh, my Lord- Jesus Christ, see Mathew-22:41-46)

²The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies. (During the millennium period – Rev-1:16)

³Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth. (womb of the morning- born of woman, in the flesh)

⁴The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. Numbers-25:19, (Melchizedek – King of the just, or, the elect) John-8:56-58

⁵The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of his wrath.

⁶He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill the places with the dead bodies; he shall wound the heads over many countries. (dead bodies- the 7,000 Nephilim – the fallen angels) Jude-1:6, also in Revelation-20:4-6 (many are spiritually dead until after the Millennium period)

⁷He shall drink of the brook in the way: therefore shall he lift up the head.

(Christ is exalted after the crucifixion)
