- 110 The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool. (The LORD- Yahoveh, my Lord-Jesus Christ, see Mathew-22:41-46)
- ²The LORD shall send the rod of thy strength out of Zion: rule thou in the midst of thine enemies. (During the millennium period Rev-1:16)
- ³Thy people shall be willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the <u>womb of the morning</u>: thou hast the dew of thy youth. (womb of the morning- born of woman, in the flesh)
- ⁴The LORD hath sworn, and will not repent, Thou art a priest for ever after the order of Melchizedek. Numbers-25:19, (Melchizedek King of the just, or, the elect) John-8:56-58
- ⁵The Lord at thy right hand shall strike through kings in the day of his wrath.
- ⁶He shall judge among the heathen, he shall fill the places with the <u>dead bodies</u>; he shall wound the heads over many countries. (dead bodies- the 7,000 Nephilim the fallen angels) Jude-1:6, also in Revalation-20:4-6 (many are spiritually dead until after the Millennium period
- ⁷He shall drink of the brook in the way: therefore shall he lift up the head.

(Christ is exalted after the crucifixion)
