

Psalm 14

A Psalm of David

King James Version (KJV)

14 The fool hath said in his heart, there is no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, there is none that doeth good.
(fool= stupid & impious)

²The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, and seek God.

³They are all gone aside, they are all together become filthy: there is none that doeth good, no, not one. (filthy= stinky)

⁴Have all the workers of iniquity no knowledge? who eat up my people as they eat bread, and call not upon the LORD.

⁵There were they in great fear: for God is in the generation of the righteous. (fear= fear & revere... Gods enemies should fear Him, His servants revere Him)

⁶Ye have shamed the counsel of the poor, because the LORD is his refuge. (poor= also means the oppressed)

⁷Oh that the salvation of Israel were come out of Zion! when the LORD bringeth back the captivity of his people, Jacob shall rejoice, and Israel shall be glad. (Jacob is used in reference to all 12 tribes)
