Psalm 83 A Song or Psalm of A-saph King James Version (KJV) The final psalm of Asaph

- **83** Keep not thou silence, O God: hold not thy peace, and be not still, O God.
- ² For, lo, thine enemies make a tumult: and they that hate thee have <u>lifted up the head</u>. (Egotistically... above God, even)
- ³They have taken crafty counsel against thy people, and consulted against thy hidden ones. (They take council to destroy Israel) (The elect, who remain faithful to God)
- ⁴They have said, Come, and let us cut them off from being a nation; that the name of Israel may be no more in remembrance. (At this time, only Judah remained. The 10 tribes to the north had already been dispersed by the Assyrians)
- ⁵ For they have consulted together with one consent: they are confederate against thee: (10 nations were together against Israel much like today)
- ⁶The <u>tabernacles</u> of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes; (tabernacles tents) (Russians, Arabs, Persians)
- ⁷Gebal, and Ammon, and Amalek; the Philistines with the inhabitants of <u>Tyre</u>; (Tyre a place of commerce of the Kenites)
- *Assur also is joined with them: they have holpen the children of Lot. Selah.
- ⁹Do unto them as unto the Midianites; as to Sisera, as to Jabin, at the brook of Kison: (God defeated them for Israel, under Gideon) (Gideon had 300, against the enemy's 135,000 men) (When God defeated Sisera for Israel, under Debohrah)
- ¹⁰ Which perished at Endor: they became as dung for the earth. See Joshua-17:11, (also the place where Saul consulted the witch)
- ¹¹ Make their nobles like Oreb, and like Zeeb: yea, all their princes as Zebah, and as Zalmunna: (princes and kings of the Medianites)
- ¹² Who said, Let us take to ourselves the houses of God in possession. 2Chronicles-20:10-11

- ¹³ O my God, make them like a <u>wheel</u>; as the stubble before the wind. (wheel- the wheel in a grain mill)
- ¹⁴ As the fire burneth a wood, and as the flame setteth the mountains on fire;
- ¹⁵ So persecute them with thy tempest, and make them afraid with thy storm.
- ¹⁶ Fill their faces with shame; that they may seek thy name, O LORD.
- ¹⁷ Let them be confounded and troubled for ever; yea, let them be put to shame, and perish:
- ¹⁸ That men may know that thou, whose name alone is JEHOVAH, art the most high over all the earth. (JEHOVAH Yahoveh- Bad translation)
