Isaiah 50

King James Version (KJV)

- **50** Thus saith the LORD, Where is the bill of your mother's divorcement, whom I have put away? or which of my creditors is it to whom I have sold you? Behold, for your iniquities have ye sold yourselves, and for your transgressions is your mother put away. (God divorced Israel, because of her idolatry, worshipping false gods. She did it to herself) Jeremiah-3:8
- ²Wherefore, when I came, was there no man? when I called, was there none to answer? Is my hand shortened at all, that it cannot redeem? or have I no power to deliver? behold, at my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make the rivers a wilderness: their fish stinketh, because there is no water, and dieth for thirst. (Has God become weak? No. God is almighty. He can redeem whom He wishes to redeem)
- ³ I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.
- The Lord God hath given me the tongue of the learned, that I should know how to speak a word in season to him that is weary: he wakeneth morning by morning, he wakeneth mine ear to hear as the learned. (Through the Holy Spirit, we have eyes to see, ears to hear, and words to speak. This speaks of the ministry of Jesus that enlightens us every day)
- ⁵The Lord GoD hath opened mine ear, and I was not rebellious, neither turned away back.
- ⁶I gave my back to the smiters, and my cheeks to them that plucked off the hair: I hid not my face from shame and spitting. (When they crucified Jesus as the Lamb slain)
- ⁷ For the Lord GoD will help me; therefore shall I not be confounded: therefore have I set my face like a flint, and I know that I shall not be ashamed. (This speaks of the Elect, who remain true in their faith to God)
- ⁸ He is near that justifieth me; who will contend with me? let us stand together: who is mine adversary? let him come near to me. (Let us stand with Jesus Christ. Who can come against us? No one can overcome God)

- Behold, the Lord God will help me; who is he that shall condemn me? lo, they all shall wax old as a garment; the moth shall eat them up. (The enemy is as nothing when compared to God's power)
- ¹⁰ Who is among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh in darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God. (Fear = revere same word in the Hebrew; Jesus is the light of the world. The Elect, the faithful, will not be confounded in the darkness of antichrist)
- ¹¹ Behold, all ye that kindle a fire, that compass yourselves about with sparks: walk in the light of your fire, and in the sparks that ye have kindled. This shall ye have of mine hand; ye shall lie down in sorrow. (Don't try to find your own salvation. God is the only Savior)
