- **12** And in that day thou shalt say, O LORD, <u>I will praise thee</u>: though thou wast angry with me, thine anger is turned away, and thou comfortedst me. (Hallelujah)
- ²Behold, God is my salvation; I will trust, and not be afraid: for the LORD JEHOVAH is my strength and my song; he also is become my salvation. (Lord Jehovah = Yah Yahoveh proper translation. There is no "J" in Hebrew; 3068 in the Hebrew dictionary) (This is God's name, documented)
- ³Therefore with joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation. (This is the water of life the living water that Jesus spoke of)
- ⁴And in that day shall ye say, <u>Praise the LORD</u>, call upon his name, declare his doings among the people, make mention that his name is exalted. (<u>Praise the LORD = Hallelujah</u>)
- ⁵Sing unto the LORD; for he hath done excellent things: this is known in all the earth.
- ⁶Cry out and shout, thou inhabitant of Zion: for great is the Holy One of Israel in the midst of thee. (God is with us, if we want Him to be)
