⁴To him who alone doeth great wonders: for his mercy endureth for ever.

⁵To him that by wisdom made the heavens: for his mercy endureth for ever.

⁷To him that made great lights: for his mercy endureth for ever:

⁸The sun to rule by day: for his mercy endureth for ever:

⁹The moon and stars to rule by night: for his mercy endureth for ever.

¹⁰To him that smote Egypt in their firstborn: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹¹And brought out Israel from among them: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹²With a strong hand, and with a stretched out arm: for his mercy endureth for ever. [\(This was done to redeem Israel, but also to teach Egypt that HE is the LORD\)](#)

¹³To him which divided the Red sea into parts: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹⁴And made Israel to pass through the midst of it: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹⁵But overthrew Pharaoh and his host in the Red sea: for his mercy endureth for ever.

¹⁶ To him which led his people through the wilderness: for his mercy endureth for ever.

¹⁷ To him which smote great kings: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹⁸ And slew famous kings: for his mercy endureth for ever:

¹⁹ Sihon king of the Amorites: for his mercy endureth for ever: (Sihon refused passage to Moses & Israel. He attacked them instead)

²⁰ And Og the king of Bashan: for his mercy endureth for ever: (Og & his people were Geber- descendents of the fallen)

²¹ And gave their land for an heritage: for his mercy endureth for ever: (Under the condition that they wipe out the Canaanites completely. Israel didn't obey, and eventually became as heathen as them)

²² Even an heritage unto Israel his servant: for his mercy endureth for ever.

²³ Who remembered us in our low estate: for his mercy endureth for ever:

²⁴ And hath redeemed us from our enemies: for his mercy endureth for ever. (redeemed- to rescue with power and strength, by breaking the bands that bind us)

²⁵ Who giveth food to all flesh: for his mercy endureth for ever.

²⁶ O give thanks unto the God of heaven: for his mercy endureth for ever. (Repeated in every verse, for emphasis) (The word mercy can also be translated love)

Psalms 135 & 136 are very similar. Writer is unknown.
