

## Numbers 29

King James Version (KJV)

**29** And in the seventh month, on the first day of the month, ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work: it is a day of blowing the trumpets unto you. (The 7<sup>th</sup> month was a special month – following the time of harvest. To rest and enjoy the fruits of their labor) (They would read the Torah to all the people) Leviticus-23:23 (The Feast of Trumps – the month of Tisser)

<sup>2</sup>And ye shall offer a burnt offering for a sweet savour unto the LORD; one young bullock, one ram, and seven lambs of the first year without blemish: (They only offered their best to God)

<sup>3</sup>And their meat offering shall be of flour mingled with oil, three tenth deals for a bullock, and two tenth deals for a ram,

<sup>4</sup>And one tenth deal for one lamb, throughout the seven lambs:

<sup>5</sup>And one kid of the goats for a sin offering, to make an atonement for you: (an atonement for the whole congregation)

<sup>6</sup>Beside the burnt offering of the month, and his meat offering, and the daily burnt offering, and his meat offering, and their drink offerings, according unto their manner, for a sweet savour, a sacrifice made by fire unto the LORD.

<sup>7</sup>And ye shall have on the tenth day of this seventh month an holy convocation; and ye shall afflict your souls: ye shall not do any work therein: (The day of atonement for all of Israel. The high priest would only enter the Holy of Holies on this one day and make atonement for the people)

<sup>8</sup>But ye shall offer a burnt offering unto the LORD for a sweet savour; one young bullock, one ram, and seven lambs of the first year; they shall be unto you without blemish:

<sup>9</sup>And their meat offering shall be of flour mingled with oil, three tenth deals to a bullock, and two tenth deals to one ram,

<sup>10</sup>A several tenth deal for one lamb, throughout the seven lambs:

<sup>11</sup> One kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the sin offering of atonement, and the continual burnt offering, and the meat offering of it, and their drink offerings. **Leviticus-16 (The Day of Atonement)**

<sup>12</sup> And on the fifteenth day of the seventh month ye shall have an holy convocation; ye shall do no servile work, and ye shall keep a feast unto the LORD seven days: **(The feast of Succouth<booths>. They all made booths from branches and palm fronds and lived there 7 days; to remember their leaving Egypt and going through the wilderness. This feast would educate the following generations of what God had done for them)**

<sup>13</sup> And ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD; thirteen young bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year; they shall be without blemish: **(Perfect sacrifices; Jesus became our perfect sacrifice for all time when He was crucified. That event ended all animal sacrifices forever)**

<sup>14</sup> And their meat offering shall be of flour mingled with oil, three tenth deals unto every bullock of the thirteen bullocks, two tenth deals to each ram of the two rams,

<sup>15</sup> And a several tenth deal to each lamb of the fourteen lambs:

<sup>16</sup> And one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>17</sup> And on the second day ye shall offer twelve young bullocks, two rams, fourteen lambs of the first year without spot: **(The number of bullocks diminishes by 1 on each day, but the other sacrifices repeat)**

**(Go to verse – 35)**

<sup>18</sup> And their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>19</sup> And one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, and the meat offering thereof, and their drink offerings.

<sup>20</sup> And on the third day eleven bullocks, two rams, fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish;

<sup>21</sup> And their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>22</sup> And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, and his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>23</sup> And on the fourth day ten bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:

<sup>24</sup> Their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>25</sup> And one kid of the goats for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>26</sup> And on the fifth day nine bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without spot:

<sup>27</sup> And their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>28</sup> And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, and his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>29</sup> And on the sixth day eight bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:

<sup>30</sup> And their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>31</sup> And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>32</sup> And on the seventh day seven bullocks, two rams, and fourteen lambs of the first year without blemish:

<sup>33</sup> And their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullocks, for the rams, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>34</sup> And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>35</sup> On the eighth day ye shall have a solemn assembly: ye shall do no servile work therein: (This Sabbath <Azarah> ends the festivals of the 7<sup>th</sup> month and of the year)

<sup>36</sup> But ye shall offer a burnt offering, a sacrifice made by fire, of a sweet savour unto the LORD: one bullock, one ram, seven lambs of the first year without blemish:

<sup>37</sup> Their meat offering and their drink offerings for the bullock, for the ram, and for the lambs, shall be according to their number, after the manner:

<sup>38</sup> And one goat for a sin offering; beside the continual burnt offering, and his meat offering, and his drink offering.

<sup>39</sup> These things ye shall do unto the LORD in your set feasts, beside your vows, and your freewill offerings, for your burnt offerings, and for your meat offerings, and for your drink offerings, and for your peace offerings.

<sup>40</sup> And Moses told the children of Israel according to all that the LORD commanded Moses. (All these sacrifices ended when Jesus Christ was crucified for our sins. Today ore sacrifice to God is our love for Him, and our holy meal with God is communion. God's Law is the Ten Commandments. This is the New Testament that Jesus <God in the flesh> established forever)
