## Psalm 91

King James Version (KJV)

- **91** He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall <u>abide</u> under the shadow of the Almighty. (abide= lodge)
- <sup>2</sup>I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. (Messiah speaks)
- <sup>3</sup> Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the <u>noisome</u> pestilence. (fowler one who hunts birds) (noisome= ruinous)
- <sup>4</sup>He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Deut-32:11 (Father is like a great eagle)
- <sup>5</sup>Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;
- <sup>6</sup> Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.
- <sup>7</sup>A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. (Those that fall are deceived by antichrist)
- <sup>8</sup>Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.
- <sup>9</sup>Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;
- <sup>10</sup> There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.
- <sup>11</sup> For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (Satan tempted Jesus by misquoting these verses in Mathew-4:6)
- <sup>12</sup>They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Mathew-4:6, another misquoted verse by Satan)

- <sup>13</sup> Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.
- <sup>14</sup> Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (God, speaking of Christ)
- <sup>15</sup> He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.
- <sup>16</sup> With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

1Chorinthians-5:6-7 (Christ became our Passover – our Sabbath- our rest) (Written in prophecy of the Messiah, and His people)
