

Psalm 91

King James Version (KJV)

91 He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (abide= lodge)

²I will say of the LORD, He is my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. (Messiah speaks)

³Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, and from the noisome pestilence. (fowler – one who hunts birds) (noisome= ruinous)

⁴He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth shall be thy shield and buckler. Deut-32:11 (Father is like a great eagle)

⁵Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; nor for the arrow that flieth by day;

⁶Nor for the pestilence that walketh in darkness; nor for the destruction that wasteth at noonday.

⁷A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; but it shall not come nigh thee. (Those that fall are deceived by antichrist)

⁸Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked.

⁹Because thou hast made the LORD, which is my refuge, even the most High, thy habitation;

¹⁰There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling.

¹¹For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (Satan tempted Jesus by misquoting these verses in Mathew-4:6)

¹²They shall bear thee up in their hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. (Mathew-4:6, another misquoted verse by Satan)

¹³Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet.

¹⁴Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (God, speaking of Christ)

¹⁵He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I will be with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honour him.

¹⁶With long life will I satisfy him, and shew him my salvation.

1Chorinthians-5:6-7 (Christ became our Passover – our Sabbath- our rest) (Written in prophecy of the Messiah, and His people)
