Ezekiel 31

King James Version (KJV)

- **31** And it came to pass in the eleventh year, in the third month, in the first day of the month, that the word of the LORD came unto me, saying,
- ²Son of man, speak unto Pharaoh king of Egypt, and to his multitude; Whom art thou like in thy greatness? (Who do you think you are? God destroyed Satan, who was far greater than you)
- ³Behold, the <u>Assyrian</u> was a <u>cedar in Lebanon</u> with fair branches, and with a shadowing shroud, and of an high stature; and his top was among the thick boughs. (Assyrian is a name given to Satan; cedar in Lebanon a translation error; the word is: t'asher, not asher = a common, scrawny box cedar; not the big cedar trees of Lebanon; t'asher is symbolic for Satan. The great cedars of Lebanon are symbolic for the Adamic peoples)
- ⁴The waters made him great, the deep set him up on high with her rivers running round about his plants, and sent her little rivers unto all the trees of the field. (God promoted him to a cherub that protects the Mercy Seat of Christ) Genesis-2:8 (the 4 rivers of Eden)
- ⁵Therefore his height was exalted above all the trees of the field, and his boughs were multiplied, and his branches became long because of the multitude of waters, when he shot forth. (His self-pride also grew greatly)
- ⁶ All the fowls of heaven made their nests in his boughs, and under his branches did all the beasts of the field bring forth their young, and under his shadow dwelt all great nations. (He gained control over others through subtlety and deceit. He attracted all the evil creatures to him)
- ⁷Thus was he fair in his greatness, in the length of his branches: for his root was by great waters. (Even a box cedar, planted in fertile ground will grow tall. What made him a box cedar in God's eyes was his lack of character and his deceitful ways)
- ⁸The cedars in the <u>garden of God</u> could not hide him: the fir trees were not like his boughs, and the chestnut trees were not like his branches; nor any tree in the garden of God was like unto him in his beauty.

 (garden of God Eden)

- ⁹I have made him fair by the multitude of his branches: so that all the trees of Eden, that were in the garden of God, envied him. (God made Satan great, before his fall from grace)
- ¹º Therefore thus saith the Lord GoD; Because thou hast lifted up thyself in height, and he hath shot up his top among the thick boughs, and his heart is lifted up in his height; (Satan's pride destroyed him)
- ¹¹ I have therefore delivered him into the hand of the mighty one of the heathen; he shall surely deal with him: I have driven him out for his wickedness. (After Satan's failed rebellion, God demoted him to a position of degradation. In the end times, antichrist will also lose his battle against God)
- ¹² And strangers, the terrible of the nations, have cut him off, and have left him: upon the mountains and in all the valleys his branches are fallen, and his boughs are broken by all the rivers of the land; and all the people of the earth are gone down from his shadow, and have left him. Isaiah-14:12-17 (This will happen on the 7th Trump, when the true Messiah returns and people will see that they have been deceived by antichrist)
- ¹³ Upon his ruin shall all the fowls of the heaven remain, and all the beasts of the field shall be upon his branches:
- ¹⁴To the end that none of all the trees by the waters exalt themselves for their height, neither shoot up their top among the thick boughs, neither their trees stand up in their height, all that drink water: for they are all delivered unto death, to the nether parts of the earth, in the midst of the children of men, with them that go down to the pit. (All those who follow Satan)
- ¹⁵ Thus saith the Lord GoD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him. (The deceived peoples mourned for antichrist when he was brought down in the first age. They will do it again at the end of this age)
- ¹⁶ I made the nations to shake at the sound of his fall, when I cast him down to hell with them that descend into the pit: and all the trees of Eden, the choice and best of Lebanon, all that drink water, shall be comforted in the nether parts of the earth.

¹⁷They also went down into hell with him unto them that be slain with the sword; and they that were his arm, that dwelt under his shadow in the midst of the heathen. (in his arm = his seed – his progeny, offspring – the Kenites) (Today, they work with the muslims to destroy Christianity)

¹⁸ To whom art thou thus like in glory and in greatness among the trees of Eden? yet shalt thou be brought down with the trees of Eden unto the nether parts of the earth: thou shalt lie in the midst of the uncircumcised with them that be slain by the sword. This is Pharaoh and all his multitude, saith the Lord God. (God did to pharaoh as He did to Satan)
