

## Psalm 96

King James Version (KJV)

**96** O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth.

<sup>2</sup> Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; shew forth his salvation from day to day. **1Chronicles-16:23-33**

<sup>3</sup> Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people.

<sup>4</sup> For the LORD is great, and greatly to be praised: he is to be feared above all gods. (**feared= revered**)

<sup>5</sup> For all the gods of the nations are idols: but the LORD made the heavens.

<sup>6</sup> Honour and majesty are before him: strength and beauty are in his sanctuary.

<sup>7</sup> Give unto the LORD, O ye kindreds of the people, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

<sup>8</sup> Give unto the LORD the glory due unto his name: bring an offering, and come into his courts. (**offering= minka - a meat or meal offering**)  
(**Today, our offering is our love**)

<sup>9</sup> O worship the LORD in the beauty of holiness: fear before him, all the earth.

<sup>10</sup> Say among the heathen that the LORD reigneth: the world also shall be established that it shall not be moved: he shall judge the people righteously.

<sup>11</sup> Let the heavens rejoice, and let the earth be glad; let the sea roar, and the fulness thereof. (**YHVH – 4 words in Hebrew – the Sacred name of God – Yahoveh** )

<sup>12</sup> Let the field be joyful, and all that is therein: then shall all the trees of the wood rejoice **Isaiah-55:12**

<sup>13</sup> Before the LORD: for he cometh, for he cometh to judge the earth: he shall judge the world with righteousness, and the people with his truth.
